

Age Demographics U.S. Census Bureau 1980, 1990, 2000, 2010, 2016, 2017 /ESRI Data 2014 Updated for 2018 LTEM with 2017 data

Highlight


The median age in the Pinelands region was estimated at 43 years of age in 2017. The State and Non-Pinelands regions exhibited similar median ages. The trend for increasing age that occurred over the decades 1980 to 2010 has flattened out in more recent years.

Description: The age distribution of the population within each municipality provides some determination of the demand for services and the ability of the population to withstand changes in tax rates.

Unit of Analysis: Demographic data is compiled at the municipal level and regionally aggregated for inside/outside the Pinelands and state analysis. Data is broken into three variables, median age, under 18 years and over 65 years of age.

Findings: The median age throughout the state has leveled off since 2010, following two decades of increases. Median age is near 43 years for the State, the Pinelands, and the Non-Pinelands regions. The median age has been near 42 or 43 since 2010 after climbing considerably from median ages in the low 30's in the 1980s. Also, the range in median age has narrowed among the three regions (State, Pinelands, and Non-Pinelands.) For the estimated median age in 2017, the Non-Pinelands region is on the high end at 43.9 years of age while the State median age is the low end of 43.1 years of age. The Pinelands region has an estimated 2017 Estimated Median Age median age of 43.3 in 2017. This gap of Under 30 less than a year difference in median age 30 - 40 40 - 50 among the three regions is distinctly narrower than 50 - 60 in 1980. At that time, the difference was two or Over 60 three years.

It appears that there may be a shift occurring in which region has the highest or lowest median age. Up through 2010 and except for the year 2014, the Non-Pinelands region had the oldest median age among the three regions. In 2014, the Pinelands region briefly held the position of having the highest median age. Until the early 2000s, the Pinelands region had the youngest median age. Since then the State median age has typically been younger than the Pinelands. Graph 1 depicts these trends in the median age from 1980 to 2017.



Graph 1. Median Age Trends 1980 - 2017

The youngest towns in the Pinelands have shifted slightly over the last year. Frequently, the youngest median age is found in municipalities surrounding Joint Base McGuire-Dix-Lakehurst. However this year, the lowest median age in the Pinelands is found in South Toms River Borough at 30 years of age. Egg Harbor City at 33 years and Lakehurst Borough at 34 years are the municipalities with the next lowest median ages.

Among the municipalities with the oldest median age, Manchester Township remains in the top position. It continues to be the only town to have a median age above 60 (64 years). The median age in Berkeley Township is the next highest at 60 years, followed by Southampton Township with a median age of 57. These median ages are consistent with median ages from 2016, except that Ocean Township and Southampton were previously tied with a median age of 56.



Under 18 age demographic: Among Pinelands municipalities, South Toms River Borough continues to retain the highest percentage of the population under the age of 18 at 31%. The next highest percentages of population under 18 years of age are found in Lakehurst Borough and Little Egg Harbor Township. Each of these municipalities has at least 29% of their population that is under the age of 18. Maurice River Township has the lowest percentage of the population under 18 years of age, at only 5% of the total population. New Hanover Township, Manchester Township and Berkeley Township are the next lowest in the under 18 age group (8%, 10%, and 13%, respectively).

Over 65 age demographic: Not

surprisingly, the municipalities with the highest median age also have the highest percentage of the population over 65 years of age. Manchester Township has the highest percentage over 65 years of age at 48%. As suggested by the high median ages, the other two municipalities with larger percentages of the population over 65 are Berkeley Township at 41% and Southampton Township at 35%. Age-restricted developments have a substantial effect on the median age in those towns. Pinelands municipalities with the lowest percentage of the population in the over-65 age demographic include New Hanover Township (4%), Maurice River Township (6%) and South Toms River Borough (8%). Maurice River Township continues the distinction of ranking low in both the lowest percentage of children (5%) and the lowest percentage of older adults (6%).

The figures on the map at right show percentages of each demographic group across southern New Jersey. Table 2, below provides more detail on these demographics for all Pinelands municipalities.
