This series consists of original military commission and appointment certificates dating from 1745 to 1901. They were issued by the following: Gov. Lewis Morris, the Provincial Congress (Hendrick Fisher and Samuel Tucker, Presidents), state governors, and the Adjutant General's Office.

- 2. Edward Hunt, Captain of company for the westerly part of Lebanon, Col. Joseph Stout's Regiment, Hunterdon County Foot Militia, Kingsberry, 18 March 1745.
- 3. Petitions to the Provincial Congress requesting military commissions for Benjamin Brearly of Maidenhead, William Chambers of Hunterdon County, and George Cottnam of Trenton, [no place], ca. 1775-1776 [3 items; Accession #1982.16/1989.36].
- 4. William Gamble, Captain of a company, First (Col. Joseph Borden's) Regiment, Burlington County Foot Militia, [no place], 30 August 1775.
- 5. Ruben Sayre, Captain of a company in Elsinborough, Eastern (Col. John Holmes') Battalion, Salem County Foot Militia, [no place], 14 May 1776.
- 6. Abner Rieves, Ensign of the Eighth Company, Western (Col. John Munson's) Regiment, Morris County Militia, Morristown, 30 July 1777 [Accession #1995.061].
- 7. Benjamin Laing Jr., Captain of the Eighth Company, Col. Moses Jaques' Regiment, Essex County Militia, Morristown, 10 April 1780.
- 8. John Munn, Captain of the Third Company, Col. Philip Van Cortlandt's Regiment, Essex County Militia, [no place], ca. 1781-1790.
- 9. Thomas Kelly, Major of the First Battalion, Fourth Regiment, Salem County Militia, Trenton, 26 November 1794 [2243 AM].

- 10. Joseph D. Price, Colonel of the Fourth Regiment, Essex County Militia, Trenton, 26 February 1830.
- 11. John J. Behan, Corporal of Company E, 2nd Regiment, 2nd Brigade, New Jersey National Guard, effective 30 April 1901, Trenton, NJ, 6 May 1901 [Accession #1995.017].
