- If the month and year are not known, no more than one two-year search can be requested for fee of <u>\$15.00</u>. Please use the forms below and fill out required information.
- Deaths from June 1878-December 1900 will be searched by fiscal year (i.e. July 1890-June 1891), not calendar year. Please specify fiscal years to be searched, if an exact date is not supplied.

### Land and Estate Records

#### Wills and Estate Inventories, 1670-1952

<u>\$10.00</u> per packet (up to 10 pages), <u>\$1.00</u> each additional page; provide the name of the deceased, approximate death date, and county or major city of residence. Include file number, if known.

Will and Estate Inventories Request Form

#### Secretary of State's Deeds, Surveys and Commissions, ca. 1650s-1790s

<u>\$5.00</u> per deed; provide the name of the grantor and grantee, location (county), and approximate year. Secretary of State Deed Request Form

#### East and West Jersey Proprietors' Surveys, 1680s-early 1900s

\$5.00 per record; provide book and page citation, names of parties, and approximate date and location of land. Some of the surveys are included in our index to Proprietary Warrants and Surveys.

# **Military Service Records**

#### **Revolutionary War**

<u>\$10.00</u> per record; provide soldier's name and other identifying information, such as county of service. <u>Request Form</u>

#### 1793 Militia Census, Wars of 1794-1815, and Mexican War (1846-1848)

<u>\$5.00</u> per record; provide soldier's name; (records of militia, wars of 1794-1812, and Mexican War copied from published transcriptions). <u>Request Form</u>

#### Civil War

<u>\$10.00</u> per record; <u>William S. Stryker's Record of Officers and Men of New Jersey in the</u> <u>Civil War, 1861-1865</u> is located on the "Searchable Databases" page of our website: <u>http://www.njarchives.org</u>. An order form can be filled out and printed based on the results of that search. The State Archives' Civil War collection includes printed rosters and muster rolls. Be sure to check the <u>Civil War Treasury Vouchers</u> database as well.

#### Spanish American War and National Guard/Punitive Expedition into Mexico, 1916

<u>\$5.00</u> per record, per conflict; provide name, company, and regiment. Request Form
