SUBJECT: Salary Cost Escalation Embedded in Consultant Agreements

## Dear Consultant:

In a letter to the consultant community dated February 27, 2013, the community was asked to continue cost escalation restrictions that were implemented on October 19, 2009. The Department appreciated that the community has adhered to the policy and wants to formally extend, with this notification, the terms of the policy through June 30, 2014.

"All new Cost Plus Fixed Fee Agreements, Fixed Price Agreements, and Extra Work Modifications will permit salary escalation of three (3) percent per annum for titles in the ASCE P1-P4/NICET I-II categories. No salary cost escalation will be allowed for higher level titles for the first 18 months of planned contract duration. For agreements with a planned duration exceeding 18 months, higher level titles will be allowed three (3) percent per annum increases for that portion of the schedule in excess of 18 months. For budgeting purposes it will be assumed that all employees receive the increase at the midpoint of the contract."
