The federal Transportation Equity Act for the 21st Century (TEA-21) provided funding for this project under Section 1601, High Priority Projects Program. The Act allocated \$14.0 M for this project. FY 2000 and FY2001 RABAs have increased the total authorization amount to \$14,368,683.

A study is underway to determine whether it is appropriate to complete the interchange. The adjacent signalized intersections of Marter Avenue and Briggs Road along Route 38 will be included in the study.
