The Subsection 14.16 Quality Control Checklist of the 2015 Roadway Design Manual has been revised to create new stipulations for the removal of rumble strips during construction staging. The purpose is to create a smooth riding surface during lane shifts and temporary travel lanes.

This revision must be read in conjunction with the referenced BDC announcement.

Implementation Code R (ROUTINE)
