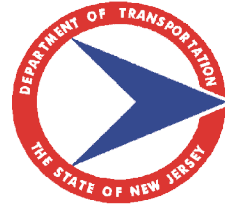

**Subject: Item Number List, 2007 (in English units) for CPM Projects**

---

This new List of Item numbers (in English Units only) is released for use in preparing Plans, Specifications, and Engineer's Estimates for the CPM projects using the *2007 Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction*. The item numbers, 2007 for non-CPM projects are also available in the database.

The item number consists of seven characters: first three numbers correspond to the specification section number; the following three numbers are sequential numbers from 001 to 999, and the suffix "M" or "P" designates if the item is either a measured quantity or a proposal quantity. This BDC Announcement does not supersede any BDC as the 2001 List of Items announced via BDC07T-03 continues to be used with current projects.

### **Implementation Code S (SPECIAL)**

The implementation plan for the 2007 item numbers is same as that of the 2007 Standard Specifications, issued via BDC Announcement BDC07S-03 dated November 16, 2007.

### **US Customary English units - Design Projects:**

2007 Item Number List shall be used on projects that are scheduled for the final design submission (FDS) **after April 15, 2008** regardless of their PDS dates.

### **Metric units - Design Projects:**

Current projects designed using Metric units may continue using the 2001 Pay Item Numbers in Metric units.
