**Description of Problem(s):** 

**Bureau(s) Affected:** All CPM Units. All Operations Units

As stated in CAN001, there have been problems identified with the use of Duracal in conjunction with impermeable protective overlays such as Latex Modified Concrete (LMC) and Microsilica Concrete (MSF). A Corrective Action Plan was established directing various units of the course of action to take in order to ensure that the product Duracal would **not** be used with these type overlays.

Considering that all bridge decks have the potential of being overlaid to extend their useful life, the use of Duracal as a deck patching material must be discontinued.

#### **Corrective Action Plan:**

Based on the above, **in no case shall Duracal be used as a bridge deck patching material.** The responsibility of each unit to ensure that this is carried out shall be as follows:

#### • BUREAU OF QUALITY MANAGEMENT SERVICES

Configuration Management Section

This office shall be responsible for making a baseline document change to Section 518.02 of Standard Input SI89 BRIDGE4 and SI96 BRIDGE1 to **remove** Duracal from the list of approved quick-setting patching materials.

#### DIVISION OF DESIGN SERVICES

Structural Engineering Bureau

This office has already initiated the above proposed specification revision.

### Bureau of Design and Engineering Support - Technical Specifications Unit

*Specification Engineers* shall be responsible for modifying Section 518.02 of Standard Input SI89 BRIDGE 4 and SI96 BRIDGE 1 of the Supplementary Specifications on all current and future projects to ensure that Duracal is removed from the list of approved quick-setting patching materials.

## • DIVISION OF CONSTRUCTION SERVICES

For all current projects under construction, Resident Engineers shall not allow the use of Duracal.

#### DIVISION OF OPERATIONS

All maintenance crews shall be informed of the above.
