SUBJECT: Revisions to Section 7, Interchanges

AASHTO has issued an updated policy on Geometric Design of Highways and Streets. The Department has adopted this 2004 policy for the design of projects. As a result, Section 7 of the 2001 *Design Manual- Roadway* is revised accordingly. The revised Section 7 shall replace the current Section 7. The remaining sections of the Design Manual are undergoing revisions and will be issued as they become available.

A summary of revisions is as follows.

- Subsection 7.2.2, Other Highways
 - Is augmented to include 6 items.
- Subsection 7.3.1, General Includes highway classification as a factor that influences the selection of interchanges.
- Subsection 7.4.5, Ramps The last sentence of item #4 is revised.
- Subsection 7.6.2, Ramp Terminals Revised to include for cross walks.
- Subsection 7.7, Additional Lanes Includes for the methodology of an "across freeway volume check".
- Subsection 7.12, Bicycle and Pedestrian Accommodations New subsection.
- Subsection 7.13, Collector Distributor Roads New subsection.

Implementation Code R (ROUTINE)

Changes must be implemented in all applicable Department projects scheduled for Final Design Submission at least one month after the date of the BDC announcement. This will allow designers to make necessary plan, specifications, and estimate/proposal changes without requiring the need for an addenda or postponement of advertisement or receipt of bids.
