



Unemployment Rates, New Jersey vs. United States January 2007 - September 2011




Shaded areas indicate national recessionary periods as determined by the NBER

Unemployment Rates, New Jersey vs. United States January 2007 - September 2011







Median Duration of Unemployment * New Jersey vs. United States: December 2007 - September 2011




New Jersey Counties Unemployment Rates - August 2011 (Preliminary, Not Seasonally Adjusted)






New Jersey Unemployment Rates by Race and Gender
