TAX ASSESSOR EXAMINATION OFFERED

The next New Jersey certified tax assessor examination will be held on Saturday, September 29, 2012. The deadline for filing applications is August 30, 2012. The test will be given at the Richard J. Hughes Justice Complex, 25 Market Street in Trenton.

New Jersey tax professionals must have a Tax Assessor Certificate when they take office. Certificates are granted only to those who pass this examination.

Exams are offered twice a year, in March and September. The purpose of the Assessor Certification and Tenure Act, which became law in 1967, is to ensure that assessors and administrators are properly trained in property tax laws and that the state has sufficient numbers of trained, career professionals to ensure a uniform and fair property tax system.
