Our records indicate that you may be currently taking a drug to lower your cholesterol and we would like to inform you of another treatment option that could save you money. Enclosed is a coupon that will allow you to save up to \$20 on your first prescription of Zocor[®]. **Zocor is a cholesterol-lowering drug that works the same way as Lipitor[®] and Crestor[®].** Depending on your Health Net plan, Zocor may be available to you at a lower copay and will be available generically at your lowest copay in Summer 2006.

Talk to Your Doctor

Zocor is a prescription drug that is taken by patients with high cholesterol when diet and other non-drug therapy are not enough. If your doctor feels Zocor is appropriate for you, please bring your new Zocor prescription along with the enclosed coupon to your pharmacy.
