

TRANSITION PERIOD

The transition period for this contract is scheduled to end on the close of business, May 12, 2006. This transition period is being granted to allow a reasonable amount of time for existing assignments in all the Regions of the State to end and for complete implementation of the new contract to begin. This is applicable to the Primary, Secondary and Tertiary Contractors.

METHOD OF OPERATION FOR USING AGENCIES

The intent of this contract is the award of a **PRIMARY AND SECONDARY BACKUP** for the **NORTHERN REGION**, and award a **Primary, Secondary and Tertiary award** for the **Central and Southern Regions**.

The following contractors have been awarded contracts for the following Regions:

**Northern Region: Primary: ACCESS NJ/CNA SERVICES
SECONDARY: JOULE' STAFFING SERVICES**

**Central Region: Primary: JOULE' STAFFING SERVICES
SECONDARY: SHARPENED IMAGE
TERTIARY: CO-WORX STAFFING SERVICES**

**Southern Region: PRIMARY: JOULE' STAFFING SERVICES
SECONDARY: SHARPENED IMAGE
TERTIARY: ADVANCED STAFFING**

The Regions are as follows:

NORTHERN: Warren, Passaic, Bergen Union, Sussex, Morris, Essex, Hudson and Somerset counties.

CENTRAL REGION: Hunterdon, Middlesex, Burlington, Monmouth and Mercer

SOUTHERN REGION: Ocean, Atlantic, Cape May, Camden, Salem, Cumberland and Gloucester

If the Primary Contractor supplied personnel cannot perform the services required, the Using Agency may request a replacement. After two (2) documented attempts at using the Primary Contractor with unsatisfactory job performance, the Using Agency may then be permitted to utilize the Secondary Contractor. Any such use of the Secondary Contractor must have (THE PROPER) clean documentation showing that personnel supplied by the Primary Contractor were unable to do (THE JOB TASK ASSIGNED) credible work. This is also applicable if the Primary Contractor cannot provide the personnel as required. The same provision applies to the Tertiary Contractor. However, the using agency(s) must document these transactions for auditing purposes.

In the event delivery of said personnel is not made within the number of days stipulated or under the schedule defined in the Request for proposal, the using agency may be authorized to obtain said personnel from any available source, the difference in price, if any, to be paid by the contractor failing to meet his commitments.
