Turnpike Authority to host public meeting on reforestation plans for Widening area

The New Jersey Turnpike Authority will hold a public meeting in East Windsor on Dec. 13 to discuss reforestation activities in the Interchange 6-9 Widening Program corridor.

The meeting will be held from 7 to 9 p.m. at the National Conference Center in the Holiday Inn, [399 Monmouth Street, East Windsor](#).

The public will be invited to present oral or written comments during the meeting. The public record will remain open until 5 p.m. on Feb. 12, 2011. Additional comments may be submitted in writing until that time to John Keller, P.E., P.M.P., Supervising Engineer, New Jersey Turnpike Authority, P.O. Box 5042, Woodbridge, NJ 07095.

Notice of the meeting was advertised in three local newspapers, distributed to the mayors and municipal clerks in eight affected municipalities and posted on the [Widening Program Web site](#).

The Widening Program, which has been under construction since 2009, will add 170 lane miles to the Turnpike between Interchange 6 in Mansfield Township, Burlington County, and Interchange 9 in East Brunswick Township, Middlesex County.
