Advisory: Proposed Readoption of N.J.A.C. 6A:31, Renaissance Schools

Trenton, NJ – Acting Commissioner of Education Angelica Allen-McMillan, Ed.D., approved the following rulemaking for publication in the June 21, 2021, *New Jersey Register:*

• Readoption with amendments of *N.J.A.C.* 6A:31, Renaissance Schools, which implements the process set forth in the Urban Hope Act to permit authorized nonprofit entities to partner with qualified school districts to provide students with new or significantly reconstructed, high-quality schools.
