CURRENT	<u>Enterovirus (EV-D68)</u> Signs and symptoms similar to cold or flu. <u>In</u> <u>children age 6 weeks to 15 years with</u> <u>existing respirtory illness may quickly</u> <u>become respiratory distress, change in skin</u> <u>color (hypoxemia) or wheezing</u> Current cases have been reported in New Jersey.	<u>Ebola</u> Patient may present signs and symptoms of flu in early stage such as high fever, severe headache, muscle pain, vomiting, diarrhea, or abdominal pain. Additional sign may be unexplained bleeding. Look for recent travel (up to 21 days) in affected areas. Current outbreaks reported in West Africa. <u>http://www.cdc.gov/vhf/ebola/outbreaks/2014-west- africa/index.html</u> Cases confirmed in US (being treated in NYC, NY, screening being conducted at major airports).

D I S P A	IF PATIENT HAS A DIAGNOSIS OF EBOLA OR IS PRESENTING HIGH FEVER AND/OR FLU-LIKE SYMPTOMS AND HAS RECENTLY TRAVELED TO AREAS OF CURRENT OUTBREAKS OR THE PATIENT IS BEING MONITORED BECAUSE THEY HAVE BEEN IN CLOSE PROXIMITY TO A KNOWN EBOLA PATIENT, ADVISE ALL RESPONDERS (Police, Fire, EMS, any others <u>directly or through their</u> <u>dispatch)TO USE P.P.E.</u>
