ABOUT THE PROGRAM

The New Jersey Department of Agriculture currently is accepting applications for department-wide Internship Program, which aims to provide highly motivated undergraduate and graduate students with hands-on training and work experience. Eligibility

Applicants must be at least 18 years old and must be attending a higher education academic institution on a full-time basis.

Selected candidate must be authorized to work in the United States according to the Department of Homeland Security, United States Citizenship, and Immigration Services regulations.

The State of New Jersey does not provide sponsorships for permanent residency to the United States or work visas.



COMPENSATION

For paid interns, compensation is in accordance with the student's current academic level:

- Undergraduate: \$20.00 per hour
- Graduate: \$21.50 per year

Unpaid internship opportunities may also be available based on division/work unit needs. There will be no monetary compensation for unpaid interns. Credits may be awarded based on students' higher education institution requirements.

HOURS AND LOCATIONS

Hours vary by division/work unit. However, hours will range between Monday and Friday from 8:00 am to 5:00 pm. The intern can work with their division /work unit supervisor to establish their hours of work.

Positions are primarily based in Trenton, Ewing, and Vineland.

PERSONAL RELATIONSHIPS DISCLOSURE

In accordance with the Uniform Ethics Code adopted by the NJ State Ethics Commission and the State Policy Prohibiting Discrimination in the Workplace, the New Jersey Department of the Agriculture requires the disclosure of all relatives, consensual personal relationships, and cohabitants. No New Jersey Department of Agriculture employee may supervise or exercise any authority with regard to personnel actions involving his/her relative, anyone with whom there is a consensual personal relationship, or anyone with whom they cohabit.

Relative means an individual's spouse/domestic partner/civil union partner, or the individual or spouse's/domestic partner's/civil union partner's parent, child, brother, sister, aunt, uncle, niece, nephew, cousin, grandparent, grandchild, son-in-law, daughter- in-law, stepparent, stepchild, stepbrother, stepsister, half-brother or half-sister, whether the relative is related to the individual or the individual's spouse/domestic partner/civil union partner by blood, marriage or adoption.

Consensual personal relationship means marriage, engagement, dating or other ongoing romantic or sexual relationships. Cohabitant means non-related persons who share a household under circumstances where there is financial interdependence.

NJDA requires the disclosure of all relatives and consensual personal relationships to be promptly reported directly to the Office of Human Resources. Confidentiality shall be maintained to the extent possible and practicable. This information may be shared with New Jersey Department of Agriculture's Ethics Office as deemed necessary. Upon receiving notice of the relationship, Administration may address any situation as necessary in consultation with the Ethics Officer. This may include, but is not limited to, changing the reporting relationships or transferring any employees/interns involved. Failure to provide notification to New Jersey Department of Agriculture's Ethics Officer may result in discipline up to and including termination and the denial of legal representation and indemnification by the State in the event that a lawsuit is filed having a connection with a personal relationship. Employees are under a continuing obligation to promptly report personal relationships that develop during the course of their employment.
