#### JOB DESCRIPTION

Under the direction of the Dairy Coordinator for Licensing and Enforcement in the Division of Marketing and Development, Department of Agriculture, will conduct Dairy Program and Organic Registration investigations and enforcement actions for retail (stores) and wholesale dealer operations; does related work as required.

#### REQUIREMENTS

**EXPERIENCE:** Strong communication skills and prior experience in the field of agriculture or agricultural education preferred, but not required.

<u>FOREIGN DEGREES</u>: Degrees and/or transcripts issued by a college of university outside of the United States must be evaluated by a reputable evaluation service at your expense. The evaluation must be included with your submiss and failure to submit the required evaluation may result in an ineligibility determination.

<u>LICENSE</u>: Appointee will be required to possess a driver's license valid in the State of New Jersey only if the operation of a vehicle, rather than employee mobility, is necessary to perform the essential duties of the position.

<u>AUTHORIZATION TO WORK</u>: Appointee must be authorized to work in the United States according to the Department of Homeland Security, United States Citizenship, and Immigration Services regulations.

**NOTE:** The State of New Jersey does not provide sponsorships for permanent residency to the United States or work visa.

#### **IMPORTANT NOTICE**

Effective September 1, 2011, NJ PL 70 (NJ First Act), requires all State employees must reside in New Jersey, unless exempted under the law, or current employees who live out-of-state and do not have a break-in service of more than seven calendar days, as they are "grandfathered." New employees or current employees who were not grandfathered and who live out-of-state have one year after the date of employment to relocate their residence to New Jersey or request an exemption. Current employees who reside in NJ must retain NJ residency, unless an exemption is obtained. Employees who fail to meet the residency requirements or obtain an exemption will be removed from employment.
