DAIRY CATTLE MANAGEMENT AND EVALUATION

The New Jersey FFA Association will participate in the New Jersey State 4-H Dairy Judging Event as the state qualifying event for National FFA Convention. This event will take place at Cedar Lane Farm in Hunterdon County – 87 Homestead Road, Oldwick, NJ 08858. It is scheduled for **Saturday, April 30, 2022**. **Please register your teams with the State FFA Office no later than Monday, April 1.** The State office will pre-register all New Jersey teams by the deadline with the New Jersey 4-H.

Preregistration is required for participation. Please register at www.judgingcard.com by **April 1, 2022**. See the next page for instructions for using judgingcard.com.

RULES

1. All participants must be FFA members in good standing in their respective chapter.
2. A team must consist of four members. Teams must be accompanied by an adult advisor/coach.
3. This event will be used to select the team to represent New Jersey FFA at the National FFA Convention in October. The winning team must receive at least 60% of the total team points to be eligible to advance. Visit the CDE & LDE Event Participation Policy Handbook for a full breakdown.
4. Contestants are not allowed to take any books or notes to the contest. Only clip boards and blank notepaper will be accepted.
5. A timekeeper will be designated; there will be a total of 12 minutes to place each class. For those classes with oral reasons, an additional 8 minutes will be allowed for taking notes on the class.
6. All contestants must wear rubber boots which can be disinfected or plastic boot covers.
7. Official dress is not necessary. However, an FFA shirt, long pants and close-toed shoes are mandatory.
8. Official score cards will be provided on the day of the event and must be turned in when requested.
9. New Jersey 4-H's rules and scoring procedures will be followed. FFA members CAN be a part of a 4-H team at this event.

NEW JERSEY 4-H EVENT PERMISSION FORM FOR YOUTH

All contestants must submit a completed Permission Form **AT THE TIME OF REGISTRATION**. These forms CANNOT be submitted on the day of the event. State FFA Staff must receive these forms in a timely manner so the forms can accompany the registration submitted to the State 4-H office.

*The Dairy Cattle Management and Evaluation CDE fee will be \$11.00 per participant payable to Treasurer, State of NJ. No lunch is included in registration. *If your chapter has at least Blue Affiliation, the fee is waived.*

From the South:

Take 295 north/95 South around Trenton to Route 31 N Follow Route 31 North through Pennington and Flemington to Route 78 in Clinton.

Take Route 78 East to Exit 24 (Route 517 North).

Follow Route 517 through the town of Oldwick.

Take the first Right on to Homestead Road.

The Farm is # 87 on the Right side of the road.

Cedar Lane Farm sign is on the end of the lane.

From the North:

Take Route 517 South through Hackettstown, over Schooleys Mountain.

Continue on 517 through the intersection of 24.

Homestead Road is on your left before you get into Oldwick, #87 is on the right.

Cedar Lane Farm sign is at the end of the lane.

Steps to using [judgingcard.com](http://www.JudgingCard.com) to register

1. Log in to www.JudgingCard.com (If you have an AET account, login using that information. If you don't have an AET account, use your chapter number for both the username and password (i.e. NJ0000). Both are case sensitive!)
2. Click on the leftmost icon at the bottom of the screen for "Registration and Information."
3. Use the month list at the top of the calendar to browse to the month of the contest you need to register for (April).
4. Click on the event link "New Jersey Dairy Cattle Evaluation CDE" on the calendar (April 30)...this will pull up the event's registration page.
5. Click the link to "Online Registration" at the top of the page.
6. Click on the link to "Registration".
7. Change the "Number of Contestants", specify an advisor, and then specify contestant names.
8. Click the "Submit Entry" button.
