### MARCH 15, 2022

- American FFA Degree Applications Due

### MAY 1, 2022

- Email "What do you hope to accomplish as a national officer?" essay (1,000 words or less) and SAE program description per year (200 characters or less per year) Office of Food, Agriculture & Natural Resources Education at [ag.ed.registration@ag.nj.gov](mailto:ag.ed.registration@ag.nj.gov).

### MAY 26, 2022

- Introduction of New Jersey's National Officer Candidate(s) at Convention Session IV (7:30pm)

### JUNE 1, 2022

- Email completed National Officer Candidate Development Form to Office of Food, Agriculture & Natural Resources Education at [ag.ed.registration@ag.nj.gov](mailto:ag.ed.registration@ag.nj.gov). This form can be found on the State Activity Guide.

### JUNE 11 OR 12, 2022

- Facilitate workshop at State Officer Leadership Training

### JUNE 15, 2022 (Tentative)

- National Officer Candidate Selection Process
