MARCH 1, 2023

- Email Letter of Application and Resume to Office of Food, Agriculture & Natural Resources Education at ag.ed.registration@ag.nj.gov.

MARCH 15, 2023

- American FFA Degree Applications Due

MAY 1, 2023

- Email “What do you hope to accomplish as a national officer?” essay (1,000 words or less) and SAE program description per year (200 characters or less per year) Office of Food, Agriculture & Natural Resources Education at ag.ed.registration@ag.nj.gov.

MAY 26, 2023

- Introduction of New Jersey’s National Officer Candidate(s) at Convention Session IV (7:30pm)

JUNE 1, 2023

- Email completed National Officer Candidate Development Form to Office of Food, Agriculture & Natural Resources Education at ag.ed.registration@ag.nj.gov. This form can be found on the State Activity Guide.

JUNE 10 OR 11, 2023

- Facilitate workshop at State Officer Leadership Training

JUNE 15, 2023 (Tentative)

- National Officer Candidate Selection Process
 - 9:00 am – 5:00 pm (all phases of the process will be evaluated)

 - d) Advisory Council Member/ Business Representative
