## **RESOLUTION #43**

## **COTTAGE FOOD REGULATIONS AND HONEY**

1	<b>WHEREAS</b> , the New Jersey Beekeepers were disappointed that Governor Murphy,
2	in January 2022, exercised a pocket veto on Senate Bill S73, despite its unanimous passage
3	by the Legislature; and
4	WHEREAS, the New Jersey Department of Health already had instituted regulations
5	on "Cottage Food" products that improperly included honey, which is a raw food product.
6	NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that we, the delegates to the 107 <sup>th</sup> State
7	Agricultural Convention, gathered in Atlantic City, New Jersey, on February 9-10, 2022, do
8	hereby request that the New Jersey Department of Health delete honey from non-TCS
9	Cottage Food product list under N.J.A.C. 8:24-1.5 definitions.
10	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that we urge the New Jersey Legislature to pass,
11	and the Governor to sign, a law stating that honey is a raw food product and not subject to
12	the Cottage Food regulations.
