

Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza (HPAI) States

HPAI was detected in poultry within 60 days in the following state and therefore all poultry and hatching eggs from this state moving into New Jersey live bird markets require a permit and 72-hour test:

South Carolina - last confirmed case April 9, 2020; permit and 72-hour test required through June 8, 2020 for all poultry and hatching eggs moving into New Jersey live bird markets.
