Protect Yourself. Protect New Jersey.

When dealing with ticks:

- Remove ticks promptly to reduce the chance of disease transmission.
- Know that all ticks could carry disease, but only blacklegged ticks carry Lyme disease.
- See your doctor if you develop symptoms (rash, fever, muscle aches) after a tick bite.
- Protect yourself from tick-borne disease.
 Use personal precautions, including repellents and long pants.
