	1. March 12: Mexican zucchini was the only vegetable offered to students. According to the PR, only 1/2 up was offered, which does not meet the 3/4 c vegetable requirement for the k-8 age/grade grouping. In addition, according to the PR, only the students that selected the planned entrée of Beef enchilada had access to the zucchini (PR shows 242 servings were planned for both, 36 leftover, and 206 served for both.) Since the alternate meals served for the day, did not have access to the required vegetable component, those meals are disallowed (318 total disallowed).
	2. The review week was either missing or insufficient in the legumes, starchy, and other vegetable subgroups.
