How Provided	Email			Comments	The Professional Standards Final Rule established the requirement for all Food Service Directors (FSD) hired after July 1, 2015 to receive food safety certification in the five years previous to hire or within 30 days after the date of hire. It also gave the State Agency the discretion to require current SFA directors to obtain food safety certification every five years. According to the Schedule A, Ruth Ungar, is listed as the FSD. Ruth's food safety certification was completed 11/22/17; therefore will soon exceed five years. This is a friendly reminder to to renew the certification before it expires.

This is a first time violation.</p> <p>At lunch, portion sizes planned for each component must meet both daily and weekly minimum requirements for each appropriate grade group. When planning menus, refer to the Lunch Meal Pattern Charts, available on the Department of Agriculture's Form web site for specific component and minimum quantity requirements. Failure to fix identified issues may also lead to fiscal action/repeat violations in subsequent reviews as these are Performance Standard 2 (PS2) violations. Explain in detail, how the finding will be corrected and the measures taken to ensure that it will not reoccur in the future.
