Nursery Certification	Certification to ensure that all nursery stock sold or distributed in New Jersey, or exportable to other states or countries is free of injurious plant pests and diseases.	Nursery Inspection Program (Main Office)	609-406-6944
Plant Dealer Certification	Certification to ensure that all nursery stock sold or distributed in New Jersey either imported from other states or countries or from New Jersey, has been inspected during the previous growing season and found to be free of injurious plant pests and diseases. Condition Statement	Official verification issued by the inspector for stock which has arrived at a nursery property from another source and does not appear as stated on accompanying nursery certificate.	Nursery Inspection Program (Main Office)	609-406-6944
Rejection Notice	Order issued by the inspector for nursery stock which has arrived at a New Jersey location from another source and may pose a threat to local plant health.	Nursery Inspection Program (Main Office)	609-406-6944
Stop Sale Notification	Order issued by the inspector stating that it is unlawful for any person to sell, allow to be sold, use or dispose of any portion of a listed plant lot without written permission from the New Jersey Department of Agriculture. State & Federal Phytosanitary Certification	Certification of regulated plant products to ensure freedom of plant pests. This is usually issued as a requirement of entry to other states or countries and facilitates the interstate/international movement of plants and plant products. Postentry Certification	Certification that facilitates the importation/introduction of new plant materials and cultivars into the United States and ensures that the imported plant materials (regulated under USDA postentry quarantine 7 CFR 330.37) are free of invasive or exotic plant pests. Blueberry Plant Inspection	Inspection to ensure that the propagative blueberry nursery stock being sold is free of virus and stunt disease.	Nursery Inspection Program (Main Office)	609-406-6944
Plant Virus Testing	Laboratory service to ensure that the propagative stock being sold is free of blueberry scorch virus (BISCV), blueberry shock virus (BISV), and tobacco streak virus (TSV).	Plant Pest Survey (Main Office)	609-406-6949
Canadian Blueberry Fruit Certification	Certification that fresh blueberry fruit is free from blueberry maggot; <i>Rhagoletis mendax</i> Curran and eligible for export to Canada under compliance with CFIA Directive D-02-04.	Nursery Inspection Program (Main Office)	609-406-6944
Rose Mosaic Virus Certification	Certification to ensure that rose plants sold in New Jersey are apparently free from rose mosaic virus.	Nursery Inspection Program (Main Office)	609-406-6944
Vegetable Transplant Inspection	Inspection to prevent the distribution of diseased or infested vegetable transplants into the state of New Jersey with special emphasis on the interception of plants with bacterial diseases and nematode infestations.	Plant Pest Survey (Main Office)	609-406-6949
Fruit Tree Nematode & Virus Testing	Laboratory service to ensure fruit tree nursery stock (<i>Prunus</i> spp.) produced in New Jersey is free of dagger nematodes & viruses.	Plant Pest Survey (Main Office)	609-406-6949
