



2021 NJ Hemp Varieties of Concern-Prohibited Varieties

This document lists some of the hemp varieties grown in New Jersey for 2020, and have had, in one or more instance, a total potential delta-9 THC test result of above 0.3%. Applicants for 2021 New Jersey's Hemp License shall review this list of hemp varieties before sourcing, purchasing, and acquiring the hemp seed, clones, propagules or cuttings which they will be growing in 2021, and shall ensure that they comply with all the requirements of the New Jersey Hemp Program. The hemp varieties on this listing are categorized as Prohibited Varieties or Varieties of Concern. Varieties listed New Jersey Prohibited Varieties will not be approved for growth in 2021.

New Jersey Varieties of Concern:

Auto CBD, Bee, Boax, Bubba Kush, Cherry Abacus 2.0, Cherry HD, Cherrywine, Early Abacus, Eclipse, Elektra, Franklin, Merlot, Mountain Mango, OT, Purple Kush, Quick Kush, Remedy, T-Bird, T1-Trump, Ultra Nevada, Wife, Work Horse, Hawaiian Haze, Frosted Lime, Special Sauce.

New Jersey Prohibited Varieties:

For New Jersey: Blue Genius, Terptown, Haute Wife, Black Cherry, Cherry #5, Sour Space Candy, Suver Haze, Lifter, Otto II Stout

For Pennsylvania 2021, the Prohibited Varieties are as follows: Baux, Boax, Brilliance, Canna-Tsu, Chab/Cherry, Cherry Shock, Eighty Eight, Endo Cherry, Oregon Cherry, Original Cherry, P3, Pink Lion, SJ1, Socats T2, Sweetened, USO 31, Young SIM 10
