Seed Sample Submission Form

A minimum of 1000 seeds is required for germination testing. Minimum weight for purity and noxious weed analysis varies by seed type. It is the responsibility of the submitter to ensure that the samples submitted are representative of the lots from which they were taken. Seeds for spring planting should be submitted between September 1 and February 1 for timely analysis. Fees for testing shall be waived for federal or state agencies, local governments and park commissions. Any New Jersey resident actively engaged in the commercial production of agricultural or horticultural products and not engaged in the business of a wholesale seedsman or seed conditioner will be allowed two free germination tests by the State Seed Laboratory during the period July 1 through June 30. Please submit payment in advance (make checks payable to address in header) if requesting germination and/or noxious weed examination. All other analysis will be billed based on number of hours for testing.
