

NEW WORLD SCREWWORM: NEW JERSEY ENTRY QUICK REFERENCE



NO ENTRY: INFESTED OR SUSPECTED ANIMAL

Any susceptible domestic animal infested with, or suspected of being infested with, NWS shall not enter New Jersey.

NO ENTRY: QUARANTINED PREMISES

No entry from a premises under NWS quarantine until the premises is officially determined free of infestation.

NEXT: Consider both origin and every state/zone through which the animal will transit before arriving in New Jersey.

Which category of state(s) or zone(s) is the animal originating from or transiting through?

| CVI / DOCUMENTATION | CVI issued within 5 days before entry, including the required inspection statement (see below) and freedom from wounds/evidence of NWS. | CVI issued within 5 days before entry with the required inspection statement (see below). Poultry may qualify for the flock-level exception below. | No additional NWS-specific documentation. | SYSTEMIC TREATMENT | Required before entry by an accredited veterinarian using an appropriately authorized systemic product. Record product name, date, and route on the CVI. | Not required for every species solely because the state contains an infested zone. See the pet rule below. | No additional NWS-specific treatment. |
| NEXT ACTION | Apply the livestock, pet, or poultry rules below. Requirements are cumulative. | Apply the livestock, pet, or poultry rules below. Requirements are cumulative. | Follow all standard New Jersey animal import requirements and verify current zone designations. | When originating in or transiting through a state containing an infested zone or adjacent surveillance zone, obtain NJDA permit approval before movement. See instructions below. | Treatment is required when originating anywhere in a state containing an infested zone or in an adjacent surveillance zone. Record product name, date, and route on the CVI. | Hatching eggs and birds 3 days old or younger are exempt from individual examination. Poultry over 3 days may use a CVI or VS Form 9-3 with the inspection statement at flock level. |

NEW WORLD SCREWORM ZONE DEFINITIONS



Infested premises

A premises where at least one presumptive positive or confirmed positive case of an animal infested with New World screwworm larvae.

Infested zone

A zone extending at least 20 km (about 12.4 miles) beyond the perimeter of the infested premises.

Adjacent surveillance zone

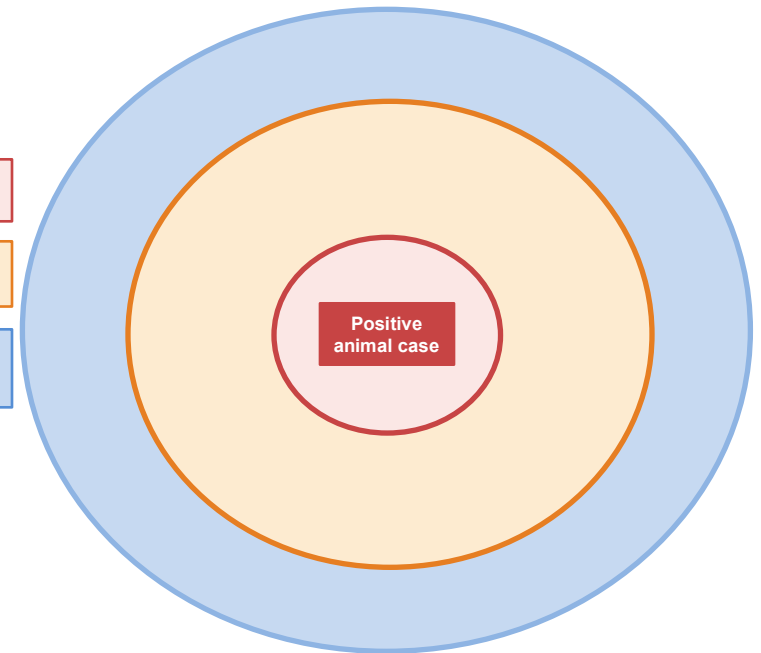
A zone that immediately surrounds the infested zone. Its perimeter is 21–40 km (about 13.1–24.9 miles) beyond the infested zone.
