

**RESOLUTION OF THE
MONMOUTH COUNTY AGRICULTURE DEVELOPMENT BOARD
DISMISSING A RIGHT TO FARM COMPLAINT WITHOUT PREJUDICE**

Mr. Geran offered the following resolution and moved its adoption:

WHEREAS, Linda Harris and David Harris [the “Complainants”], residing at [redacted], Colts Neck, New Jersey, filed a Right to Farm Complaint [“Complaint”] against Sam Crispi, owner, and Tom Orgo, farmer [the “Respondents”], of [redacted], Colts Neck, New Jersey [“the Farm”] on July 26, 2010; and

WHEREAS, a site visit was organized by the Monmouth County Agriculture Development Board [the “Board”] staff to investigate the complaint, which was conducted by: Amanda Brockwell, Right to Farm Coordinator; Bill Sciarappa, Rutgers Cooperative Extension Service; Sharif Branham, US Department of Agriculture – National Resource Conservation Service; Dave Clapp, NJ Department of Agriculture; Tom Frank, Colts Neck Health Officer; Tom Geran, Board Member; and William Potter, Vice Chairman of the Board; and

WHEREAS, a Right to Farm Hearing [“Hearing”] was scheduled for September 1, 2010; and

WHEREAS, the Complainants were notified of the Hearing in writing on August 11, 2010 and August 25, 2010, yet failed to appear; and

WHEREAS, the Respondents did appear at the Hearing and were prepared to defend themselves; and

WHEREAS, the Board unanimously voted to dismiss the Complaint without prejudice

on September 1, 2010.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Complaint is hereby dismissed without prejudice.
