Pursuant to the Open Public Meetings Act, N.J.S.A. 10:4-6 to -21, the New Jersey Board of Public Utilities hereby gives notice of a Special Public Meeting to be held on Monday, April 27, 2020 at 12:00 p.m. to consider the following two matters:

Docket No. QO18070698 – In the Matter of the Closure of the SREC Registration Program Pursuant to P.L. 2018, c.17 – Procedure for Seeking Waiver of Permission to Operate Rules for Substantively Complete Projects Unable to Receive Final Inspection Due to the COVID Crisis.

The Board will consider waiving Permission to Operate rules for solar projects which are constructed, but have not been able to receive final interconnection approvals from local authorities or the Electric Distribution Companies, because of the COVID crisis.
