- A. [Docket No. EF21070997 – In the Matter of the Petition of Atlantic City Electric Company Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 48:2-13 and N.J.S.A. 48:3-9 for Authority to Issue up to \\$350 Million of Short-Term Indebtedness Prior to January 1, 2024.](#)

Short-term debt issued under this authorization, up to \$350,000,000 to be issued on or before January 1, 2024, is intended for the purposes of funding maturing previously issued debt, working capital, short-term financing of construction expenses, and other general corporate purposes.

- B. [Docket No. EF21060943 – In the Matter of the Petition of Public Service Electric and Gas Company Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 48:3-7 and 48:3-9 for Authority, from January 1, 2022 through December 31, 2023, to Sell and/or Encumber Property and Purchase, Issue and Sell Debt.](#)

Long-term debt issued by the company under this authorization is anticipated to be used to provide funds for financing the physical plant and facilities, construction and/or other general corporate purposes, including refinancing of existing, maturing long-term debt. This authorization is for up to \$3,175,000,000 of debt to be issued on or before December 31, 2023.
