The Board will consider Jersey Central Power & Light Company’s proposed Infrastructure Investment Program. The parties have executed a stipulation which, if approved by the Board, would authorize the Company to conduct a modified Infrastructure Investment Program.

The parties executed a stipulation which, if approved by the Board, would result in an increase of \$0.78 to the monthly bill of a typical residential customer.

The parties executed a stipulation which, if approved by the Board, would result in an increase of \$0.87 to the monthly bill for a typical residential heating customer using 100 therms per month.

- D. Docket No. GR24070553 – In the Matter of the Petition of Elizabethtown Gas Company to (1) Revise the Clean Energy Program Component of its Societal Benefits Charge Rate and (2) Revise its On-System Margin Sharing Credit.

The Board will consider Elizabethtown Gas Company's July 2024 petition seeking to revise the Clean Energy Program component of its Societal Benefits Charge rate and its On-System Margin Sharing Credit. The parties executed a stipulation which, if approved by the Board, would result in an increase of \$0.61 to the monthly bill of a typical residential heating customer.

- E. Docket Nos. BPU GR24060371 and OAL PUC 15749-24 – In the Matter of the Petition of Elizabethtown Gas Company to Review its Periodic Basic Gas Supply Service Rate and Conservation Incentive Program Rates for the Year Ended September 30, 2025.

The Board will consider the Initial Decision of Administrative Law Judge Jones approving a stipulation of settlement for final rates for Elizabethtown Gas Company's 2024 Periodic Basic Gas Supply Service and Conservation Incentive Program.

- F. Docket No. ER23070453 – In the Matter of Jersey Central Power & Light Company's Verified Petition Seeking Review and Approval of the Net Deferred Costs Included in its COVID-19 Regulatory Asset and Establishment of a COVID-19 Recovery Charge ("JCP&L Initial CRC Filing").

The Board will consider Jersey Central Power & Light Company's request for review and approval of the deferred costs in the company's COVID-19 Regulatory Asset. The parties executed a stipulation which, if approved by the Board, would result in an initial monthly increase of \$0.28 for the typical residential customer.

The Board will consider New Jersey Natural Gas Company's September 2024 petition seeking modifications to the Remediation Adjustment and New Jersey Clean Energy Program components of its Societal Benefits Charge. The parties executed a stipulation which, if approved by the Board, would result in a monthly increase of \$0.57 for a typical residential customer using 100 therms in a winter month.
