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EXECUTIVE SESSION

After appropriate motion, the following matter, which involved pending litigation and/or attorney-client privilege, was discussed in Executive Session.

8. CLEAN ENERGY

A. Docket No. QO18080969 – In the Matter of Clean Energy Program Administrator.

Discussion: Stacy Ho Richardson, Deputy Director of Clean Energy, presented this matter, and it pertained to the extension of TRC Environmental Corporation's (TRCs) contract by one year for administration and management services for New Jersey's Clean Energy Program (NJCEP). TRC's original contract is from 2015 and had a base term of three years, with the option to extend for an additional three one-year periods. The contract expires on November 30, 2021. The contract extension request was tied to the time anticipated to be necessary to complete the procurement process for a successor administrator of the Clean Energy Program.

With respect to the procurement process, Clean Energy Staff had been working with the Board's Office of Budget and Finance, as well as the Office of Information Technology to develop and finalize a Request for Proposal (RFP). The RFP is for a successor administrator of the Clean Energy Program that takes into account the energy efficiency transition, new solar programs, the School and Small Business Energy Efficiency Stimulus Programs, and all necessary aspects of the future administration of NJCEP. Staff submitted the RFP to the Division of Purchase and Property of the Treasury Department (DPP), and they are working with DPP on the RFP approval process.

Staff sought approval to confirm with the DPP that the Board seeks to extend TRC's contract by one year under Section 5.3 of the State Standard Terms and Conditions to provide continuity of services until a new contract is awarded. Staff will notify TRC by October 30, 2021 of the State's intent to extend the term and period of performance of the contract.

After appropriate motion, the Board reconvened to Open Session.

There being no further business before the Board, the meeting was adjourned.
