#### BY THE BOARD:

On July 11, 2008, Cozy Formal Wear ("Petitioner") filed a petition with the Board requesting a formal hearing related to alleged improper billing by New Jersey American Water Company ("Respondent").

After the filing of Respondent's answer, the Board transmitted this matter to the Office of Administrative Law ("OAL") for hearing and initial disposition as a contested case pursuant to N.J.S.A. 52:14B-1 et seq. and N.J.S.A. 52:14F-1 et seq. This matter was assigned to Administrative Law Judge ("ALJ") Gail M. Cookson.

While this matter was pending at the OAL, the parties engaged in negotiations and entered into and signed a Settlement Agreement and Release ("Agreement") that was submitted to ALJ Cookson. By Initial Decision issued on November 17, 2008, and submitted to the Board on November 25, 2008, to which the Agreement was attached and made a part thereof, ALJ Cookson found that the Agreement was voluntary, that its terms fully disposed of all issues in controversy, and that it satisfied the requirements of N.J.A.C. 1:1-19.1. Pursuant to the terms of the Agreement, the Petitioner shall pay the Respondent \$300.00 within thirty days of the Agreement and Petitioner will further dismiss its petition with prejudice. If payment is not made in a timely manner, the Respondent may proceed with its collection process for \$2,455.98, the total amount in controversy. In addition, Petitioner releases any and all claims it may have against the Respondent with respect to past bills and, upon timely payment by the Petitioner,

Respondent will release any and all claims for unpaid amounts with regards to past bills on Petitioner's account.

After review and consideration of the Initial Decision and the Agreement of the parties, the Board <u>HEREBY FINDS</u> that, by the terms of the agreement, the parties have resolved all outstanding contested issues in this matter. Accordingly, the Board <u>HEREBY ADOPTS</u> the Initial Decision and agreement of the parties in their entirety as if fully set forth herein.

On October 17, 2008, I convened an in-person settlement conference at which time significant progress toward an amicable resolution was reached. The parties subsequently submitted a fully executed settlement document which is attached hereto and made part hereof. I have reviewed the record and terms of the Settlement Agreement and Release and FIND:

1. The parties have voluntarily agreed to the settlement as evidenced by the

WHEREAS, Cozy Formal Wear ("Petitioner"), has filed a Petition with the Board of Public Utilities wherein it disputed bills from New Jersey-American Water Company, Inc. and its predecessor ("NJAWC" or "Company"), for water usage at the property located at 1001

Stuyvesant Avenue, Union, New Jersey (the "Property"); and

WHEREAS, the Company answered Petitioner's Complaint and requested the Board of Public Utilities require Petitioner to pay the full amount in dispute; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Public Utilities assigned Docket No. WC08070489U to this matter and transferred it to the Office of Administrative Law, which assigned it Docket No. PUCCC09911-2008N; and

WHEREAS, the Petitioner and Company wish to resolve this matter without the necessity for further litigation;

#### IT IS THEREFORE AGREED AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. Petitioner will pay the Company Three Hundred Dollars (\$300.00) within thirty (30) days of entry of this Settlement Agreement.
  - 2 Petitioner will dismiss its Petition with prejudice.

- 3. If Petitioner fails to pay the agreed amount in satisfaction of its previous bills for the Property within thirty (30) days specified above, the Company reserves the right to proceed with collection process for the total amount in controversy, \$2,455.98.
- 4. Petitioner releases any and all claims it may have with respect to past bills against the Company.
- 5. Upon payment of the amount specified in this Settlement Agreement within the specified time period of thirty (30) days, the Company will release any and all claims for unpaid amounts with respect to the bills from the Property.

This Settlement Agreement may be subject to the Board of Public Utilities' approval.
