BY THE BOARD:

On April 27, 2009, Sherrie Cornell ("Petitioner") filed a petition with the Board requesting a formal hearing related to a billing dispute with Public Service Electric and Gas Company ("Respondent" or "PSE&G") regarding a bill for utility service provided by Respondent.

After the filing of Respondent's answer, the Board transmitted this matter to the Office of Administrative Law ("OAL") for hearing and initial disposition as a contested case pursuant to N.J.S.A. 52:14B-1 et seq. and N.J.S.A. 52:14F-1 et seq. This matter was assigned to Administrative Law Judge ("ALJ") Edward J. Delanoy, Jr.

While this matter was pending at the OAL, the parties engaged in negotiations and entered into and signed a Stipulation of Settlement ("Settlement") that was submitted to the ALJ. By Initial Decision issued on December 24, 2009, to which the Settlement was attached and made part thereof, ALJ Delanoy found that the Settlement was voluntary, that its terms fully disposed of all issues in controversy and that it satisfied the requirements of N.J.A.C. 1:1-19.1. The Initial Decision was filed with the Board on January 7, 2010. Pursuant to the terms of the Settlement, Respondent has agreed to credit the Petitioner's account in the amount of \$1,750.00. In return, Petitioner has agreed to pay \$125.00 per month towards the outstanding balance on the

account plus current bills beginning on January 15, 2010. Petitioner also agreed to pay her PSE&G bills for electric and gas service in a timely manner.

After review of the Initial Decision and Settlement of the parties, the Board <u>HEREBY FINDS</u> that, by the terms of the Stipulation of Settlement the parties have resolved all outstanding contested issues in this matter. Accordingly, the Board <u>HEREBY ADOPTS</u> the Initial Decision and the Stipulation of Settlement executed by the parties in their entirety as if fully set forth herein.



STATEMENT OF THE CASE

On September 25, 2009, this matter was transmitted to the Office of Administrative Law (OAL) for hearing as a contested case pursuant to N.J.S.A. 52:14B-1 to -15 and N.J.S.A. 52:14F1 to -13.

A telephone conference was held on November 17, 2009. Subsequently, the parties agreed to settle the matter and filed the attached executed Stipulation of Settlement and Dismissal.

After reviewing the record and the settlement, FIND:

- The parties have voluntarily agreed to the settlement as evidenced by the signatures or the signatures of the representatives.
- 2. The settlement fully disposes of all issues in controversy and is consistent with the law and is in the public interest.

Therefore, CONCLUDE that this agreement meets the requirements of N.J.A.C. 1:1-19.1(d) and should be approved. It is further ORDERED that the parties comply with the settlement terms and the proceedings be CONCLUDED.

I hereby FILE my initial decision with the BOARD OF PUBLIC UTILITIES for consideration.

This recommended decision may be adopted, modified or rejected by the BOARD OF PUBLIC UTILITIES, which by law is authorized to make a final decision in this matter. If the Board of Public Utilities does not adopt, modify or reject this decision within forty-five (45) days and unless such time limit is otherwise extended, this recommended decision shall become a final decision in accordance with *N.J.S.A.* 52:14B-10.

The Parties on behalf of itself and any and all of its subsidiaries and affiliated corporations, companies and divisions, its and their predecessors, successors and assigns, and its and their respective directors, stockholders, officers and employees, hereby acknowledges, fully and forever remises, releases and discharges each other from any and all claims, demands, agreements, contracts, covenants, representations, warranties, promises, undertakings, damages, debts, accounts, reckonings, bonds, bills, controversies, damages, judgments, causes of action, suits, dues, sums of money, costs and expenses of each and every kind and nature, whether in
