BY THE BOARD:

On January 25, 2007, Ethel & Lucy, Inc., t/a Ain't We Sweet (Petitioner), filed a petition with the Board disputing the bill of Public Service Electric and Gas Company (Respondent) for utility services.

After the filing of Respondent's answer, the Board transmitted this matter to the Office of Administrative Law (OAL) for hearing and initial disposition as a contested case pursuant to N.J.S.A. 52:14-B-1 et seq. and N.J.S.A. 52:14F-1 et seq. The matter was assigned to Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) Mumtaz Bari-Brown.

While this matter was pending at the OAL, the parties engaged in negotiations and reached a settlement that was submitted to the ALJ. By Initial Decision submitted to the Board on September 20, 2007, to which the settlement was attached and made part thereof, ALJ Bari-Brown found that the agreement was voluntary, that its terms fully disposed of all issues in controversy and that it met the requirements of N.J.A.C.1:1-19.1.

Pursuant to the terms of the agreement, Respondent agreed to issue a credit of \$3,555.05 to the balance of Petitioner's account, in addition to any other prior credits or sales adjustments issued on the account, leaving a balance due as of August 2, 2007, in the amount of \$3,490.00. In return, Petitioner agreed to pay to Respondent \$50.00 per month plus current monthly bills until the past due amount is paid in full. Petitioner further agreed to release and discharge

Respondent from all claims and causes of action, known or unknown, up to the date of the settlement.

After review and consideration, the Board <u>FINDS</u> that the terms of the settlement are fair and reasonable. Therefore, the Board <u>HEREBY ADOPTS</u> the Initial Decision and the Settlement Agreement in their entirety, incorporating the terms thereof into this final decision as if fully set forth at length herein.



BEFORE MUMTAZ BARI-BROWN, ALJ:

This matter was transmitted to the Office of Administrative Law (OAL) on October 24, 2005, for resolution as a contested case pursuant to N.J.S.A. 52:14B-1 to -15 and N.J.S.A. 52:14F1 to -13.

A hearing was scheduled for September 27, 2007. Prior to the date of hearing the parties settled the matter. The attached Stipulation of Settlement was submitted on September 18, 2007, indicating the terms of agreement which are incorporated herein by reference.

Having reviewed the record and the settlement terms, I FIND:

- 1 The parties have voluntarily agreed to the settlement as evidenced by their signatures and/or the signatures of their representatives.
- 2. The settlement fully disposes of all issues in controversy and is consistent with the law.

I CONCLUDE that this agreement meets the requirements of N.J.A.C. 1:1-19.1 and that the settlement should be approved. I approve the settlement and, therefore, ORDER that the parties comply with the settlement terms and that these proceedings be concluded.
