BY THE BOARD:

On April 25, 2006, Barbara Einhorn (Petitioner) filed a petition with the Board disputing the bill of Public Service Electric and Gas Company (Respondent) for utility services.

After the filing of Respondent's answer, the Board transmitted this matter to the Office of Administrative Law (OAL) for hearing and initial disposition as a contested case pursuant to N.J.S.A. 52:14-B-1 et seq. and N.J.S.A. 52:14F-1 et seq. The matter was assigned to Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) Jeffrey A. Gerson.

While this matter was pending at the OAL, the parties engaged in negotiations and reached a settlement that was submitted to the ALJ. By Initial Decision submitted to the Board on August 24, 2007, to which the settlement was attached and made part thereof, ALJ Gerson found that the agreement was voluntary, that its terms fully disposed of all issues in controversy and that it met the requirements of N.J.A.C.1:1-19.1.

Pursuant to the terms of the agreement, Respondent agreed to issue a credit of \$558.38 to the balance of Petitioner's account as of August 6, 2007, which was in the amount of \$958.38, leaving an unpaid balance of \$400.00. In addition, Respondent further agreed to change and test Petitioner's meter. In return, Petitioner agreed to pay \$50.00 per month plus current bills beginning in September 2007, and continuing for 8 months thereafter until the past due amount of \$400.00 is paid in full.

After review and consideration, the Board <u>FINDS</u> that the terms of the settlement are fair and reasonable. Therefore, the Board <u>HEREBY ADOPTS</u> the Initial Decision and the Settlement Agreement in their entirety, incorporating the terms thereof into this final decision as if fully set forth at length herein.

STIPULATION OF SETTLEMENT
