BY THE BOARD:

On January 16, 2007, Dawn Matthews (Petitioner) filed a petition with the Board disputing the bill of Public Service Electric and Gas Company (Respondent) for utility services.

After the filing of Respondent's answer, the Board transmitted this matter to the Office of Administrative Law (OAL) for hearing and initial disposition as a contested case pursuant to N.J.S.A. 52:14-B-1 et seq. and N.J.S.A. 52:14F-1 et seq. The matter was assigned to Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) Donald J. Stein.

While this matter was pending at the OAL, the parties engaged in negotiations and reached a settlement that was submitted to the ALJ. By Initial Decision submitted to the Board on July 26, 2007, to which the settlement was attached and made part thereof, ALJ Stein found that the agreement was voluntary, that its terms fully disposed of all issues in controversy and that it met the requirements of N.J.A.C. 1:1-19.1.

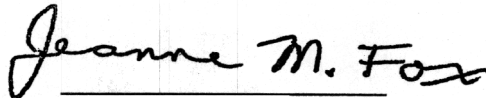
Pursuant to the terms of the agreement, Respondent has issued a credit to Petitioner's account in the amount of \$1,425.57 leaving a past due amount of \$1,000.00. In return, Petitioner has agreed to pay \$100.00 per month, beginning on August 20, 2007, and continuing for 10 months until the past due amount is paid in full. Petitioner will also continue to pay the current budget payment of \$200.00 per month until May 2008, at which time the budget amount will be recalculated.

After review and consideration, the Board FINDS that the terms of the settlement are fair and reasonable. Therefore, the Board HEREBY ADOPTS the Initial Decision and the Settlement Agreement in their entirety, incorporating the terms thereof into this final decision as if fully set forth at length herein.

This matter was transmitted to the Office of Administrative Law on March 1, 2007, for determination as a contested case, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 52:14B-1 to -15 and N.J.S.A. 52:14F-1 to -13.

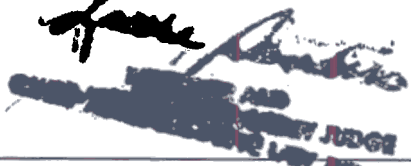

STIPULATION OF SETTLEMENT

This matter having been brought before the New Jersey Board of Public Utilities by the Petitioner, Dawn Matthews ("Petitioner"), against Respondent Public Service Electric and Gas Company ("PSE&G" or "Respondent") and transferred to the Office of Administrative Law before the Honorable Donald J. Stein, A.L.J., for utility service rendered by PSE&G to the Petitioner at 113 Linden Street, Camden, New Jersey 08102, and the Parties having agreed to settle this matter, hereby set forth the terms and conditions of their settlement agreement as follows:

As of May 29, 2007, balance was \$2,444.54

2. PSE&G will credit Petitioner's account \$1,425.57, leaving a past due amount of \$1,018.97
3. Petitioner agrees to pay \$100 per month beginning August 20, 2007 and continuing for ten (10) months thereafter until the past due amount is paid in full
4. Petitioner will continue to pay the current budget payment of \$242.00 per month until May 2008, when the budget amount is re-calculated.
