BY THE BOARD:

On August 9, 2007, Pratap Jaindani ("Petitioner") filed a petition with the Board disputing the bill of New Jersey Natural Gas Company ("Respondent") for gas services.

After the filing of Respondent's answer, the Board transmitted this matter to the Office of Administrative Law ("OAL") for hearing and initial disposition as a contested case pursuant to N.J.S.A. 52:14B-1 et seq. and N.J.S.A. 52:14F-1 et seq. This matter was assigned to Administrative Law Judge ("ALJ") John Schuster III.

While this matter was pending at the OAL, the parties engaged in negotiations and entered into and signed a Stipulation of Settlement ("Stipulation") that was submitted to the ALJ. By Initial Decision issued on March 7, 2008, and submitted to the Board on March 13, 2008, to which the Stipulation was attached and made part thereof, ALJ Schuster found that the Stipulation was voluntary, that its terms fully disposed of all issues in controversy and that it satisfied the requirements of N.J.A.C. 1:1-19.1. Pursuant to the terms of their settlement, the Respondent credited Petitioner's gas service accounts #xxxxxxxxx43 and #xxxxxxxxx60 in the amounts of \$9,681.23 and \$850.81, respectively. In return, the Petitioner agreed to pay the amount of \$4,006.62, towards gas service account #xxxxxxxxx27.

After review of the Initial Decision and the Stipulation of the parties, the Board HEREBY FINDS that the terms of the Stipulation represent a fair and reasonable resolution of all outstanding contested issues. Accordingly, the Board HEREBY ADOPTS the Initial Decision and the Stipulation of Settlement of the parties in their entirety as if fully set forth herein.

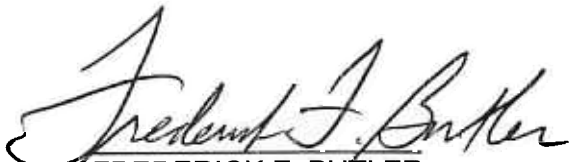

BEFORE JOHN SCHUSTER III, ALJ:

This matter was transmitted to the Office of Administrative Law on November 8, 2007, for determination as a contested case, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 52:14B-1 to -15 and N.J.S.A. 52:14F-1 to -13.

The parties have agreed to a settlement and have prepared a Stipulation of Settlement (J-1) indicating the terms thereof, which is attached and fully incorporated herein.

have reviewed the record and the terms thereof and I **FIND**:

1. The parties have voluntarily agreed to the settlement as evidenced by their signatures or their representatives' signatures.
2. The settlement fully disposes of all issues in controversy and is consistent with the law.

I **CONCLUDE** that this settlement meets the requirements of N.J.A.C. 1:1-19.1 and that the settlement should be approved. I approve the settlement and therefore **ORDER** that the parties comply with the settlement terms and that these proceedings be concluded.

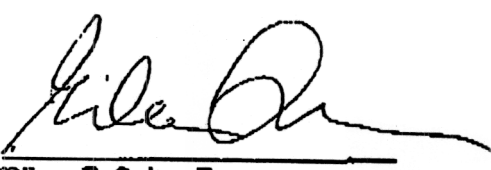
STIPULATION OF SETTLEMENT
