#### BY THE BOARD:

The New Jersey Board of Public Utilities' (the "Board") SMARTSTART Buildings Program ("SSBP" or "SMARTSTART"), Direct Install Program and Pay-for Performance Program offer financial incentives to New Jersey property owners to encourage the installation of energy efficient products and technologies. Eligible applicants may receive incentives for a portion of the cost of installing energy efficient technologies such as lighting, HVAC, water heating or other measures in new or existing buildings.

Imclone Systems, Inc. has submitted an application for a monetary incentive in the amount of \$1,029,455.00 under the Pay-for-Performance program. This rebate application, Docket Number EO10090672, has an estimated total energy savings of 21% and is receiving an incentive of \$24,925.00 for the energy reduction plan (ERP), \$602,718.00 for the Air Change Reduction, Cooling Coil Supply Air Temp Optimization, Replace Final Filters w/ Low Differential Pressure Filters, Chilled Water Temp Increase & Side Stream Water Cooled Chiller for Process Load, Hot Water Temp Reset, Boiler Combustion Controls Upgrade & variable frequency drives (VFD) on Forced Draft Fan, VFD on Process Water Pump Motors, Modify Sprayball to reduce Pressure, Lighting Occupancy Sensors, Relamp T8 fluorescents w/ 25W Lamps, Replace Metal Halide Fixtures w/ Induction Lighting Fixtures, Replace Metal Halide Lamps, Loading Dock Door Seals to be installed at 33 Imclone Drive, Branchburg, NJ and \$401,812.00 for the one year true up of its ERP.

Glass Garden Inc. / Rockaway ShopRite Assc., Inc. Roselle Park, NJ has submitted an application for a monetary incentive in the amount of \$356,107.00 under the Pay-for-Performance program. This rebate application, Docket Number EO10090673, with an estimated total energy savings of 46% and is receiving an incentive of \$6000.00 for the energy

reduction plan (ERP), \$210,064.00 for LED Reach-In Lighting, Defrost Controls, ECM Motors-Reach-in, Energy Recovery Modules, Compressor Upgrade Systems installed at 204 West Passaic Street, Roselle Park, NJ and \$140,107.00 for the one year true up of its ERP.

TRC, the Market Manager engaged by the Board to manage the New Jersey Clean Energy Program C&I energy efficiency programs, has submitted a certification that the incentives for which TRC now seeks approval to commit have been calculated in accordance with the program policies and procedures, and that the listed amounts are the true and accurate estimated incentives for which each applicant is eligible. Further, Applied Energy Group, in its role as the NJCEP Program Coordinator, has reviewed the application(s) and submitted a certification that the incentives for which TRC now seeks approval to commit have been calculated in accordance with the program policies and procedures, and that the listed amounts are the true and accurate estimated incentives for which each applicant is eligible. Based on the above, the Staff recommends that the Board approve the above referenced applications.

The Board <u>HEREBY APPROVES</u> the aforementioned applications for the incentive amounts requested and <u>AUTHORIZES</u> issuance of a standard commitment letter to the applicants identified above, setting forth the terms and conditions of these commitments.
