BY THE BOARD:

On December 18, 2006, Verizon New Jersey, Inc. ("Verizon") was granted a system-wide franchise by the Board to provide cable television service to 316 municipalities¹ pursuant to newly enacted amendments to the State Cable Television Act, N.J.S.A. 48:5A-1 et seq. (the "Act").² Through subsequent filings as provided in N.J.A.C. 14:18-14.14(a), Verizon is currently authorized to provide service to 369 municipalities. The Act, as amended, allows for the granting of competitive system-wide franchises for providers of cable television service by the Board.

P.L.2006, <u>c.</u>83 imposes requirements upon the system-wide franchise applicant, including commitments as to line extension policies, public, educational and governmental ("PEG") access channels, interconnections, free cable and internet service to public schools and municipal buildings, training and equipment for access users, return feeds, and compliance with customer protection regulations. <u>N.J.S.A.</u> 48:5A-28. Specific to the instant matter is the provision of free internet service, pursuant to <u>N.J.S.A.</u> 48:5A-28(k). A cable television company holding a system-wide franchise is required, where requested by a municipality, to install and maintain, without charge, to each municipality served by the system-wide franchise, one service outlet activated for internet service to each fire station, public school, police station, public library and any other such building used for municipal purposes.

In January 2008, the Township of Montville ("Township") requested Verizon to provide internet service to 49 locations in the Township. Verizon claimed that service to some of the structures listed did not fall under the definition of a "building used for municipal purposes."

On December 15, 2008, the Township filed a petition requesting that the Board order Verizon to provide service to certain municipal service properties. On December 30, 2008, Verizon filed an answer to the petition. On January 30, 2009, the Office of Cable Television held a pretransmittal settlement conference with the parties. The parties requested that the Board not transmit the petition while they attempted to resolve the matter, however no settlement was reached. On November 23, 2009, the Township requested that the Board transmit the matter to the Office of Administrative Law ("OAL") for further proceedings.

On January 13, 2010, the Board transmitted the matter to the OAL for hearing as a contested case. The matter was assigned to Administrative Law Judge ("ALJ") Leland S. McGee. Telephone and prehearing conferences were held, and plenary hearing dates were set; however, on September 20, 2010, the parties signed a Settlement Agreement. On September 16, 2010 and September 20, 2010, Verizon and the Township, respectively, signed a Stipulation of Dismissal with prejudice of the herein referenced case. Both the Settlement Agreement and the Stipulation of Dismissal were submitted to ALJ McGee. On September 30, 2010, ALJ McGee issued an Initial Decision-Settlement, which was submitted to the Board on October 4, 2010. ALJ McGee found that the Settlement was voluntary, that its terms fully disposed of all issues in controversy and that it satisfied the requirements of N.J.A.C. 1:1-19.1.

Pursuant to the specific terms of the Settlement, which state that the definition of facility³ is exclusively for the purposes of reaching a settlement in this matter:

- 1 Verizon agrees to install and maintain at no cost to the Township one free FiOS service outlet activated for internet service to any Township owned and maintained facility that can be entered by Township staff or employees for municipal purposes.
- In order to qualify for free installation by Verizon, the facility must be within 150 feet of Verizon's activated FiOS plant. For any greater distance, the Township may pay Verizon the additional cost to construct the drop beyond the standard installation length or construct at its own cost a facility meeting Verizon's requirements.
- 3. Verizon will make internet service available, as required by N.J.S.A. 48:5A-28(k), within 90 days to any facility in the Township where Verizon has passed the facility with activated FiOS plant, as specified in the Settlement Agreement at Attachment A, Part A. "FiOS Available."
- 4. The parties acknowledge that FiOS has only been deployed within certain portions of the Township and that Verizon is under no obligation to install any facility until such time as it passes the location with activated FiOS plant. Verizon will make internet service available, as required by N.J.S.A. 48:5A-28(k), to any remaining facility in the Township within 90 days of the date that Verizon passes the facility with activated

FiOS plant, as specified in the Settlement Agreement at Attachment A. Part B. "FiOS Not Yet Available."

After review of the record and the Initial Decision-Settlement, the Board HEREBY CONCLUDES that the parties have voluntarily agreed to the settlement as evidenced by their signatures and that by the terms of the Settlement Agreement, have fully resolved all outstanding contested issues in this matter.

Accordingly, the Board HEREBY ADOPTS the Initial Decision-Settlement executed by the Township and Verizon in its entirety as if fully set forth herein.

SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

This Agreement made this doth day of Soptember, 2010, by and between:

TOWNSHIP OF MONTVILLE, a municipal corporation of the State of New Jersey, having a principal address of 195 Changebridge Road, Montville, New Jersey (hereinafter referred to as "Township"); and

VERIZON NEW JERSEY, INC., a domestic corporation of the State of New Jersey, having a principal address of 540 Broad Street, Newark, New Jersey (hereinafter referred to as "Verizon").

RECITALS

WHEREAS, Verizon is a public utility regulated by the State of New Jersey Board of Public Utilities; and,

WHEREAS, Verizon obtained a system-wide franchise for the provision of cable services; and,

WHEREAS, currently, Verizon provides FiOS services within specific areas of the Township of Montville; and,

WHEREAS, the statutes and regulations controlling for a system-wide franchise requires Verizon to provide a commitment to provide internet service (hereafter, FiOS service), without charge, through one service outlet activated for basic service to any and all fire stations, public schools, police stations, public libraries, and other such buildings used for municipal purposes as cited at N.J.S.A. 48:5A-28; and,

WHEREAS, the Township and Verizon differed as to their respective interpretations of the requirements found at N.J.S.A. 48:5A-28 in respect to the type of buildings used for municipal purposes; and,

WHEREAS, on or about December 15, 2008, the Township filed a Petition with the New Jersey Board of Public Utilities bearing Docket No. C008121074 seeking determination that Verizon's interpretation of the system-wide franchise requirements was unreasonable and contrary to statute and further ordering Verizon to provide the Township with free service drops; and

WHEREAS, the matter having been referred to the Office of Administrative Law for further proceedings under Docket No. CTV-01436; and,

WHEREAS, the Township and Verizon now seek to settle their dispute:

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants and terms as set forth herein, the Township and Verizon hereby agree as follows:

1. Facilities to be Served. Verizon agrees to install and maintain at no cost to the Township one free FiOS service outlet to any Township owned and maintained facility that can be entered by Township staff or employees for municipal purposes. The term "facility" as designated above shall mean any enclosed structure or building used formunicipal purposes, whether above or below ground level, that has human accessibility and contains equipment or machinery that utilizes electrical utilities and offers environmentally conditioned space, conduit, access and power for the normal operation of Verizon's facilities and equipment at no additional cost to Verizon. The Township shall be responsible for all equipment damaged by failing to maintain environmental suitability. The term "facility" shall not include any facilities within the Township that

do not meet the criteria specified above and shall not be construed to limit service requirements to buildings used for municipal purposes as identified in N.J.S.A. 48:5A-28. To the extent the facility at any location is at a greater distance than Verizon's standard drop length of 150 feet, the Township may elect to pay Verizon the additional cost to construct the drop beyond the standard installation length or construct at Township's cost a facility meeting the requirements of this Paragraph 1 within the standard installation distance.

Service Deployment. It is understood by and between the parties that 2. currently, while the Township is within the service area of Verizon FiOS, the infrastructure for same has only been installed within certain portions of the Township. The Township has identified in Attachment A to this Agreement the addresses of current To the extent Verizon currently has passed these facility locations with facilities. activated FiOS fiber and subject to those facilities meeting the qualifications stated in Paragraph 1 above, Verizon will make available internet service equivalent to internet service required under N.J.S.A. 48:5A-28.k to those facilities within 90 days of this Agreement being fully executed and delivered to Verizon. With respect to facility locations identified in Attachment A that are not currently passed with activated FiOS fiber, Verizon will deploy internet service equivalent to internet service required under N.J.S.A. 48:5A-28.k subject to those facilities meeting the qualifications stated in Paragraph 1 above within 90 days of the date Verizon passes the location of those facilities with activated FiOS fiber. Verizon will provide internet service as set forth in this Agreement so long as Verizon is generally required to provide internet service under N.J.S.A. 48:5A-28.k under Verizon's system-wide franchise.

- 3. Confidentiality. It is hereby understood and stipulated between the parties that in furtherance of this Settlement Agreement, Verizon may disclose, and the Township and its officers, agents and employees may be exposed to, or come to have knowledge of information and materials that Verizon deems as proprietary and confidential. It is hereby covenanted by the Township, and on behalf of its officers. agents and employees that any and all such information that has been deemed confidential or proprietary by Verizon shall not be disclosed to any third party without the express written consent of Verizon and may only be used for purposes that are in furtherance of this Agreement. It is hereby stipulated and agreed that Verizon maintains any and all such rights over information and material it deems proprietary and confidential and the willful or knowing release of any such confidential or proprietary information by the Township, or any of its officers, agents or employees shall be deemed a breach of this covenant. Verizon reserves any and all such rights as it may have in law or equity to enjoin or prohibit any such release and may seek appropriate sanctions for same.
- 4. Parties Bound. The parties to this Settlement Agreement wish this Settlement Agreement to be final and binding upon the parties, and the obligations, rights and covenants existing hereunder shall inure to each parties' successors, heirs, agents and/or assigns.
- 5. Dismissal. Upon execution, and in consideration of the terms contained above, the Township and Verizon shall execute and file with the Office of Administrative Law and the Board of Public Utilities a Stipulation of Dismissal as to the within matter.

Each party expressly authorizes their respective attorneys to execute the Stipulation of Dismissal on their behalf.

6. Notices. Notice shall be deemed effective between the parties by delivery using the United States Mail, first-class to the addressees below:

- Costs and Attorneys Fees. Each party to this agreement shall be responsible for its own attorney fees and costs.
- Representations. Each signatory to this agreement acknowledges that they are authorized agents empowered to bind their respective party to the terms and conditions of this agreement and it is further understood that the Township's acceptance of this agreement is subject to the adoption of an appropriate resolution of the governing body authorizing the execution of this agreement.
- 9. Enforcement. Except as to the covenants within Paragraph 3 above, the Township and Verizon agree to make good-faith best efforts to resolve any future disputes that may arise regarding the implementation or interpretation of this Settlement Agreement. In the event that the parties cannot resolve any dispute that may arise regarding the implementation or interpretation of this Settlement Agreement, the parties covenant to first engage in non-binding mediation with a neutral mediator prior to

commencing any formal proceeding. The costs of such mediation shall be borne equally between the parties.

Settlement Purposes Only. The definition of facility as set forth in this

Agreement is intended for use exclusively for the purposes of reaching settlement as set forth in this agreement. Verizon does not agree that the facility as defined herein constitutes a definition of building used for municipal purposes pursuant to N.J.S.A.

constitutes a definition of building used for municipal purposes pursuant to 14.1.5.A.

48:5A-28 and reserves the right to challenge any effort to enforce such an interpretation

in any other proceeding.
