ORDER ADOPTING INITIAL DECISION SETTLEMENT

BY THE BOARD:

On November 18, 2009, Frank and Barbara Grazioli ("Petitioners") filed a petition with the Board of Public Utilities ("Board") requesting a formal hearing related to a billing dispute with Public Service Electric and Gas Company ("Respondent") for utility services rendered by Respondent.

After the filing of Respondent's answer, the Board transmitted this matter to the Office of Administrative Law ("OAL") for hearing and initial disposition as a contested case pursuant to N.J.S.A. 52:14B-1 et seq. and N.J.S.A. 52:14F-1 et seq. This matter was assigned to Administrative Law Judge ("ALJ") Susan M. Scarola.

While this matter was pending at the OAL, the parties engaged in negotiations and entered into and signed a Stipulation of Settlement ("Stipulation") that was submitted to the ALJ. By Initial Decision issued on October 5, 2010, and submitted to the Board on October 7, 2010, to which the Stipulation was attached and made part thereof, ALJ Scarola found that the Stipulation was voluntary, that its terms fully disposed of all issues in controversy and that it satisfied the requirements of N.J.A.C. 1:1-19.1. Pursuant to the terms of the Stipulation, Respondent has agreed to credit Petitioners' account in the amount of \$1,000.00 leaving an outstanding balance on that account of \$1,062.72. In return, Respondent has agreed, starting with the October 2010

bill, to pay current bills plus \$100.00 each month for the next ten (10) months and to pay the current bill plus the \$62.72 balance in the eleventh month. Petitioners furthered agreed that payments shall be made by the 20th of each month, that they will pay their electric bills in a timely manner and that they will withdraw their request for a hearing.

After review of the record and the Stipulation of Settlement of the parties, the Board <u>HEREBY FINDS</u> that the parties have voluntarily agreed to the settlement as evidenced by their signatures and that by the terms of the Stipulation of Settlement, have fully resolved all outstanding contested issues in this matter.

Accordingly, the Board <u>HEREBY ADOPTS</u> the Initial Decision and the Stipulation of Settlement executed by the parties in their entirety as if fully set forth herein.

BEFORE SUSAN M. SCAROLA, ALJ:

This matter was transmitted to the Office of Administrative Law on February 4, 2010, for determination as a contested case, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 52:14B-1 to -15 and N.J.S.A. 52:14F-1 to -13.

After several prehearing conferences, hearing was scheduled for July 21, 2010, but adjourned at the request of petitioner. The matter was rescheduled for October 5, 2010. On the record closed date a faxed executed settlement agreement was received indicating the terms of the settlement.

have reviewed the record and the terms of settlement and I FIND:

- The parties have voluntarily agreed to the settlement as evidenced by their agreement or their representatives' agreement as set forth above.
- 2. The settlement fully disposes of all issues in controversy and is consistent with the law.

I CONCLUDE that this agreement meets the requirements of N.J.A.C. 1:1-19.1 and that the settlement should be approved. I approve the settlement and therefore ORDER that the parties comply with the settlement terms and that these proceedings be concluded.

I hereby FILE my initial decision with the BOARD OF PUBLIC UTILITIES for consideration.

This recommended decision may be adopted, modified or rejected by the BOARD OF PUBLIC UTILITIES, which by law is authorized to make a final decision in this matter. If the Board of Public Utilities does not adopt, modify or reject this decision within forty-five days and unless such time limit is otherwise extended, this recommended decision shall become a final decision in accordance with N.J.S.A. 52:14B-10.

STIPULATION OF SETTLEMENT

This matter having been brought before the Office of Administrative Law by the Petitioners, Frank and Barbara Grazinfi ("Petitioner"), against Respondent Public Service Electric and Gas Company ("PSE&G" or "Respondent") for willty service rendered by PSE&G to the premises 419 (the "Property") and the Parties having agreed to settle this matter, hereby set forth the terms and conditions of their settlement agreement as follows:

- PSE&G will credit Petitioners' account no. (######27 18 in the amount of \$1,000 and 1. Petitioners will withdraw request for a bearing.
- The current account balance is \$2,062.72 less the \$1,000 adjustment will leave a balance 2. of \$1,062.72.
- Starting with October, 2010 bill, Petitioners agree to pay current bills plus \$100.00 each 3. month for the next ten (10) months and pay the current bill plus the \$62.72 balance in the eleventh month.
