BY THE BOARD:

On October 17, 2008, Adenah Bayoh ("Petitioner") filed a petition with the New Jersey Board of Public Utilities ("Board") on behalf of Petitioner and the Irvington International House of Pancakes, requesting a formal hearing related to a billing dispute with Public Service Electric and Gas Company ("Respondent") for utility services rendered by Respondent.

After the filing of Respondent's answer, the Board transmitted this matter to the Office of Administrative Law ("OAL") for hearing and initial disposition as a contested case pursuant to N.J.S.A. 52:14B-1 et seq. and N.J.S.A. 52:14F-1 et seq. This matter was assigned to Administrative Law Judge ("ALJ") Walter M. Braswell.

While this matter was pending at the OAL, the parties engaged in negotiations and entered into and signed a Stipulation of Settlement ("Stipulation") that was submitted to the ALJ. By Initial Decision issued on April 28, 2010, and submitted to the Board on May 4, 2010, to which the Stipulation was attached and made part thereof, ALJ Braswell found that the Stipulation was voluntary, that its terms fully disposed of all issues in controversy and that it satisfied the requirements of N.J.A.C. 1:1-19.1. Pursuant to the terms of the Stipulation, Respondent agreed to credit the amount of \$8,408.08 to Petitioner's account. In return, Petitioner agreed to pay Respondent the amount \$1,700.00 within 10 days of April 12, 2010 and to pay their bills for electric and gas service provided by Respondent in a timely manner.

After review of the record and the Stipulation of Settlement of the parties, the Board HEREBY FINDS that the parties have voluntarily agreed to the settlement as evidenced by their signatures and that by the terms of the Stipulation of Settlement, have fully resolved all outstanding contested issues in this matter.

Accordingly, the Board HEREBY ADOPTS the Stipulation of Settlement executed by the parties in its entirety as if fully set forth herein.



BEFORE WALTER M. BRASWELL, ALJ:

On January 16, 2009, this matter was transmitted to the Office of Administrative Law (OAL) for hearing as a contested case pursuant to N.J.S.A. 52:14B-1 to-15 and N.J.S.A. 52:14F 1 to-13. A telephone prehearing was conducted on March 5, 2009 at which time the hearing was scheduled for October 7, 2009 which continued on April 12, 2010. During the pendency of the April hearing, the parties reached a tentative settlement. On April 27, 2010 the parties submitted the Stipulation of Settlement.

I have reviewed the record and terms of the Stipulation of Settlement and FIND:

OAL DKT. NO. PUC 01286-09

1. The parties have voluntarily agreed to the settlement as evidenced by the

signatures of the parties or their representatives.

2. The settlement fully disposes of all issues in controversy and is consistent

with law.

I CONCLUDE that the agreement meets the requirements of N.J.A.C. 1:1-19.1

and therefore, it is ORDERED that the parties comply with the settlement terms and that

these proceedings be and are hereby concluded.

I hereby FILE my initial decision with the BOARD OF PUBLIC UTILITIES for

consideration.

This recommended decision may be adopted, modified or rejected by the

BOARD OF PUBLIC UTILITIES, which by law is authorized to make a final decision in

this matter. If the Board of Public Utilities does not adopt, modify or reject this decision

within forty-five (45) days and unless such time limit is otherwise extended, this

recommended decision shall become a final decision in accordance with N.J.S.A.

STIPULATION OF SETTLEMENT

This matter having been brought before the Office of Administrative Law by the Petitioner, Adenah Bayoh/IHOP ("Petitioner"), against Respondent Public Service Electric and Gas Company ("PSE&G" or "Respondent") for utility service rendered by PSE&G to the premises 1212 Springfield Avenue, Irvington, New Jersey (the "Property") and the Parties having agreed to settle this matter, hereby set forth the terms and conditions of their settlement agreement as follows:

- PSE&G agrees to credit the amount of \$8,408.08 to Petitioner's account no. 67 131 788 04.
- Petitioner agrees to pay PSE&G \$1,700.00 within ten (10) days of April 12, 2010.
- Going forward, Petitioner agrees to pay their PSE&G bill for electric and gas service in a timely manner.
