BY THE BOARD:

The New Jersey Board of Public Utilities' (the Board) Commercial & Industrial (C&I) Energy Efficiency Program includes nine (9) individual programs targeting the commercial and industrial market segments, consisting of New Construction, Retrofit, Pay for Performance - New Construction, Pay for Performance - Existing Buildings, Local Government Energy Audit, Direct Install, Combined Heat and Power Fuel Cells, Large Energy Users Program, and the Societal Benefits Charge Credit Program. These programs collectively offer financial incentives to encourage the installation of energy efficient products and technologies. Eligible applicants may receive incentives for a portion of the cost of installing energy efficient technologies such as lighting, heating, ventilation and air conditioning (HVAC), water heating and other measures in new or existing buildings.

Crestbury Estates Urban Renewal, LLC, in Brick, NJ, has submitted an application for a total financial incentive in the amount of \$580,856.30 under the 2013 Pay for Performance – Existing Buildings program, for a multi-family building project located at Crestbury Estates, 2553 South 8th Street, Camden, NJ 08104. The estimated first incentive, for the energy reduction plan (ERP), is \$29,426.30. The estimated second incentive, for completed performance-based installation of recommended energy efficiency measures, including lighting upgrades, boiler replacement, low flow water fixtures, window replacement, installation of HVAC) controls, caulking and weather-stripping of openings and doors, and attic insulation, is \$275,715. The estimated third incentive, for the post construction benchmarking report, is based on the one-year true up of the ERP, is \$275,715. This project has an estimated 43.5% total energy savings, which translates into an estimated annual energy savings of 297,436 kWh of electricity, 190 kW in electric demand, and 194,398 therms of natural gas. With an estimated total

installation cost of \$1,474,150, this application will have an estimated annual energy cost savings of \$215,610, resulting in a payback period of 6.84 years and an internal rate of return of 12.9%.

TRC Energy Services, the Market Manager engaged by the Board to manage the New Jersey Clean Energy Program (NJCEP) C&I energy efficiency programs, has submitted certification that the incentive for which TRC now seeks approval to commit has been calculated in accordance with the program policies and procedures, and that the listed amount is the true and accurate estimated incentive for which the applicant is eligible. Further, Applied Energy Group, in its role as the NJCEP Program Coordinator, has reviewed the application and submitted certification that the incentive for which TRC now seeks approval to commit has been calculated in accordance with the program policies and procedures, and that the listed amount is the true and accurate estimated incentive for which the applicant is eligible. Based on the above, Staff recommends that the Board approve the above-referenced application.

The Board <u>HEREBY ORDERS</u> the approval of the aforementioned application for the total estimated incentive amount of \$580,856.30 for Crestbury Estates Urban Renewal, LLC, and <u>AUTHORIZES</u> issuance of a standard commitment letter to the applicant identified above, setting forth the terms and conditions of this commitment.
