BY THE BOARD:

On August 14, 2013, Dr. Faizul and Angela Kahn ("Petitioner"), filed a petition with the Board of Public Utilities ("Board") requesting a formal hearing related to a billing dispute with Public Service Electric and Gas Company ("Respondent") for utility services rendered by Respondent.

After the filing of Respondent's answer, the Board transmitted this matter to the Office of Administrative Law ("OAL") for hearing and initial disposition as a contested case, on October 25, 2013, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 52:14B-1 et seq. and N.J.S.A. 52:14F-1 et seq. This matter was assigned to Administrative Law Judge ("ALJ") Kimberly A. Moss.

While this matter was pending at the OAL, the parties engaged in negotiations and entered into and signed a Stipulation of Settlement ("Stipulation") that was submitted to the ALJ. By Initial Decision issued on January 6, 2014, and received by the Board on January 9, 2014, to which the Stipulation was attached and made part thereof, ALJ Moss found that the Settlement was voluntary, that its terms fully disposed of all issues in controversy and that it satisfied the requirements of N.J.A.C. 1:1-19.1. Pursuant to the terms of the Settlement, and in order to fully resolve this matter, the parties have agreed that: (1) Respondent will credit Petitioner's account in the amount of \$757.00 to be issued in the form of a check; and (2) Respondent will continue to maintain Petitioner's Equal Payment Plan.

After review of the record and the Stipulation of Settlement of the parties, the Board **HEREBY FINDS** that the parties have voluntarily agreed to the Stipulation as evidenced by their signatures and that, by the terms of the Stipulation, have fully resolved all outstanding contested issues in this matter.





BEFORE **KIMBERLY A. MOSS**, ALJ:

This matter was transmitted to the Office of Administrative Law (OAL) for hearing as a contested case pursuant to N.J.S.A. 52:14B-1 to-15 and N.J.S.A. 52:14F 1 to- 13. A telephone prehearing was conducted on November 20, 2013. A status conference was conducted on December 11, 2013 wherein the parties engaged in extensive settlement discussions and resolved all issued in dispute. On December 31, 2013 respondent's counsel submitted a Stipulation of Settlement, via electronic mail. The original Stipulation of Settlement was received on January 6, 2014, which is attached hereto for reference.

I have reviewed the record and terms of the Stipulation of Settlement and **FIND**:


1. The parties have voluntarily agreed to the settlement as evidenced by the signatures of the parties or their representatives.
2. The settlement fully disposes of all issues in controversy and is consistent with law.

I **CONCLUDE** that the agreement meets the requirements of N.J.A.C. 1:1-19.1 and therefore, it is **ORDERED** that the parties comply with the settlement terms and that these proceedings be and are hereby concluded.

I hereby **FILE** my initial decision with the **BOARD OF PUBLIC UTILITIES** for consideration.

This recommended decision may be adopted, modified or rejected by the **BOARD OF PUBLIC UTILITIES**, which by law is authorized to make a final decision in this matter. If the Board of Public Utilities does not adopt, modify or reject this decision within forty-five (45) days and unless such time limit is otherwise extended, this recommended decision shall become a final decision in accordance with N.J.S.A. 52:14B-10.


STIPULATION OF SETTLEMENT




