BY THE BOARD:1

On December 13, 2013, 5704 Hudson Realty, L.L.C. ("Petitioner") filed a petition with the Board of Public Utilities ("Board") requesting a formal hearing related to a billing dispute with United Water New Jersey ("Respondent") for utility services rendered by Respondent.

After the filing of Respondent's answer, the Board transmitted this matter to the Office of Administrative Law ("OAL") for hearing and initial disposition as a contested case pursuant to N.J.S.A. 52:14B-1 et seq. and N.J.S.A. 52:14F-1 et seq. This matter was assigned to Administrative Law Judge ("ALJ") Kimberly A. Moss.

While this matter was pending at the OAL, the parties engaged in negotiations and entered into and signed a Settlement Agreement ("Agreement") that was submitted to the ALJ. By Initial Decision issued on June 15, 2015 and submitted to the Board on June 16, 2015, to which the Agreement was attached and made part thereof, ALJ Moss found that the Agreement was voluntary, that its terms fully disposed of all issues in controversy and that it satisfied the requirements of N.J.A.C. 1:1-19.1.

Pursuant to the Agreement, which resolves a dispute with respect to unbilled and unpaid charges for water consumption at premises located at 5704 Hudson Avenue, West New York, New Jersey, the Petitioner has agreed to pay the total settlement sum of \$44,152.47 to Respondent in full and final satisfaction for unbilled and unpaid water consumption provided at the subject premises. The parties have further agreed that the Agreement supersedes any prior bills and that the Petitioner is free to share the information with the North Hudson Sewer Authority in the event that an additional sewer bill may be required.

The parties have also agreed that Respondent could reserve its right to collect \$63,074.96 in the event that the Petitioner defaults in the making of the settlement payment or tampers with the meter after the date of the Agreement. As part of the Agreement, Petitioner will voluntarily dismiss its petition in this matter.

After review of the Initial Decision and the Agreement of the parties, the Board HEREBY FINDS that the parties have voluntarily agreed to the Agreement as evidenced by their signatures and that by the terms of the Agreement have fully resolved all outstanding contested issues in this matter.

Accordingly, the Board **HEREBY ADOPTS** the Initial Decision and Agreement executed by the parties in their entirety as if set forth at length herein.

The effective date of this order is August, 1, 2015.



BEFORE KIMBERLY A. MOSS, ALJ:

This matter was transmitted to the Office of Administrative Law (OAL) for hearing as a contested case pursuant to N.J.S.A. 52:14B-1 to-15 and N.J.S.A. 52:14F 1 to-13. A telephone prehearing was conducted during which time the hearing date was scheduled. Several hearings and telephone conferences were scheduled, the last being March 23, C. Vachier 2015. During the March 23, 2015 conference the parties resolved all issues in dispute. On June 12, 2015 respondent's counsel submitted a Stipulation of Settlement, which is attached hereto for reference.

I have reviewed the record and terms of the Stipulation of Settlement and FIND:

- 1. The parties have voluntarily agreed to the settlement as evidenced by the signatures of the parties or their representatives.
- 2. The settlement fully disposes of all issues in controversy and is consistent with law.

I **CONCLUDE** that the agreement meets the requirements of <u>N.J.A.</u>C. 1:1-19.1 and therefore, it is **ORDERED** that the parties comply with the settlement terms and that these proceedings be and are hereby concluded.

I hereby FILE my initial decision with the BOARD OF PUBLIC UTILITIES for consideration.

This recommended decision may be adopted, modified or rejected by the BOARD OF PUBLIC UTILITIES, which by law is authorized to make a final decision in this matter. If the Board of Public Utilities does not adopt, modify or reject this decision within forty-five (45) days and unless such time limit is otherwise extended, this recommended decision shall become a final decision in accordance with N.J.S.A. 52:14B-10.

WHEREAS SELIM NESIMI & 5704 HUDSON REALTY LLC (hereinafter "Customer") and UNITED WATER NEW JERSEY, (hereinafter "UWNJ") have agreed to a resolution of a dispute with respect to unbilled and unpaid charges for water consumption at premises at 5704 Hudson Avenue, West New York, New Jersey, it is hereby agreed by said parties as follows:

- 1. Customer agrees to pay the total settlement sum of \$44,152.47 to UWNJ for the unbilled and unpaid water consumption provided to the premises at 5704 Hudson Avenue, West New York, New Jersey, in full and final satisfaction of the disputed bill issued by UWNJ to Customer, dated August 21, 2013, copy of which is attached hereto as "EXHIBIT A".
- 2. This settlement agreement supersedes the disputed bills, and constitutes a new service charge for the usage of water that shall be paid as and due within ten (10) days of the date of this Settlement Agreement. Said parties agree that Customer is free to share the content of this settlement agreement with NORTH HUDSON SEWER AUTHORITY (hereinafter "NHSA") in the event that a sewer bill results from the unbilled water consumption that is the subject of this settlement agreement. Said parties acknowledge that NHSA is separate from and unaffiliated with UWNJ and UWNJ has no input or control with respect to NHSA, its management or operations.
- 3. UWNJ reserves the right to collect \$63,074.96 in the event that Customer defaults in making the settlement payment due per the settlement agreement or tampers with the meter after the date of this Agreement.
 - 4. Customer agrees to file voluntary dismissals of its complaints against UWNI filed

and/or pending in: (i) the Office of Administrative Law under Docket Number W-1312117011 and (ii) the Superior Court of New Jersey, Bergen County under Docket Number L-869-15 within 7 days of the date hereof.

5. This Settlement is not an acknowledgment of wrongdoing by either party.



On May 31, 2013, the Company filed its first Distribution System Improvement Charge (DSIC) related to infrastructure improvements. As a result, the Company will be implementing a surcharge effective July 15, 2013. The surcharge is a fixed amount based on meter size and is only applicable to General Metered and Private Fire customers.

The New Jersey State Board of Public Utilities (BPU) has approved a rate increase effective December 19, 2011 for United Water New Jersey customers that is related primarily to system improvements. The typical residential customer will see an average bill increase of \$4.67 per month or approximately 16 cents per day. A schedule of new rates is being prepared and will be sent to you in the form of a bill insert and can also be viewed on our website at www.unitedwater.com.
