OF FRANCHISE AGREEMENT

BY THE BOARD:

New Jersey Natural Gas ("NJNG" or "Company"), a regulated public utility subject to the jurisdiction of the New Jersey Board of Public Utilities ("Board"), is a corporation duly organized under the laws of the State of New Jersey engaged in the distribution and transportation of natural gas to approximately 530,000 residential, commercial and industrial customers located in Monmouth and Ocean Counties, and parts of Middlesex, Burlington, and Morris counties in New Jersey.

NJNG currently provides natural gas service within the Borough of Red Bank ("Borough") to 4,618 residential customers and 1,446 commercial customers. The Company's franchise to use the streets within the Borough for the provision of gas service expired on March 17, 2019.¹ On March 27, 2019, by Resolution No. 19-77 ("Resolution"), the Borough renewed NJNG's franchise for a period of 50 years, and granted NJNG consent to lay, maintain, and operate gas facilities in the Borough. A copy of the Resolution is attached to this Order as Exhibit "A". By letter dated April 26, 2019, NJNG accepted and agreed to the terms and conditions of the Resolution consistent with N.J.S.A. 48:3-16. Copies of the letter of acceptance and the hearing notice are attached to this Order as Exhibits "B" and "C," respectively.

¹ The Board notes that municipal consents often expire some time prior to their renewal even when the Company initiates the renewal process prior to the expiration of the previous term. This is primarily the result of the time necessary for a municipality to fulfill the legal requirements that attend to all formal actions it must take along with the additional time for hearing and Board approval as required by law. The Board has been assured that pending review of its petition, NJNG represents that it has continued to provide service to its customers within the Borough in an uninterrupted manner.

On March 12, 2020, NJNG filed a petition with the Board, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 48:2-14 and N.J.A.C. 14:1-5.5, seeking approval of the franchise renewal agreement granted by the Borough. As required by law and after notice, a municipal consent hearing in this matter was held on August 17, 2020. Heather Weisband, Esq., the Board's duly appointed hearing officer, presided over the hearing. Appearances were made on behalf of the Company, the New Jersey Division of Rate Counsel ("Rate Counsel") and Board Staff. No other party participated in the hearing or filed any written comments with the Board related to this matter.

At the hearing, the Company relied on its petition and exhibits filed with the Board and presented the testimony of Joseph Puglisi, Supervising Engineer. According to Mr. Puglisi's testimony and discovery responses, NJNG anticipates growth in the Borough over the next five (5) years of approximately 50 to 75 customers annually. Mr. Puglisi also testified that the Company has the capacity to meet the anticipated level of growth within the municipality and has no plans to change its gas distribution system within the Borough.

Rate Counsel, in its written comments to the petition dated October 2, 2020, indicated that it does not object to the Company's petition since the Company represented that it has the capacity necessary to continue to provide natural gas service to the Borough. The term of the municipal consent related to the use of streets is limited to a term of 50 years. However, Rate Counsel requested the approval of the petition include certain restrictions which are incorporated in this Order.

DISCUSSION AND FINDINGS

After careful review and consideration of the petition and exhibits submitted in this matter, the Board **HEREBY FINDS** that the renewal of the franchise agreement granted to NJNG by the Borough of Red Bank is necessary and proper for the public convenience, and properly serves the public interest, and that NJNG has the ability to continue to provide safe, adequate, and proper service. The Board **FURTHER FINDS** that the Company has the necessary experience, financial capability, capacity, and facilities in the Borough to continue to provide adequate and appropriate service to its existing and future customers, and that the 50 year duration of the municipal consent to use the streets is consistent with N.J.S.A. 48:3-15. Accordingly, the Board, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 48:2-14, **HEREBY APPROVES** the consent granted to NJNG by the Borough to continue to provide gas service, and for the continued use of its public streets for that purpose for a period of 50 years.


The approval granted hereinabove shall be subject to the following provisions:

1. As required by N.J.S.A. 48:3-15, and limited by the Resolution, the municipal consent to construct, maintain and operate gas lines in the streets and other public places in the Borough is limited to a term not exceeding 50 years.
2. This Order shall not be construed as directly or indirectly fixing for any purposes whatsoever the value of any tangible or intangible assets now owned or hereafter to be owned by NJNG.
3. This Order shall not affect, nor in any way limit, the exercise of the authority of this Board or of the State in any future petition or in any proceedings with respect to rates, franchises, services, financing, accounting, capitalization, depreciation, or in any other matters affecting NJNG.


This Order shall be effective on November 28, 2020.



**BOROUGH OF RED BANK
 COUNTY OF MONMOUTH
 RESOLUTION NO. 19-77**

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING RENEWAL OF THE FRANCHISE
 AGREEMENT WITH NEW JERSEY NATURAL GAS COMPANY**

WHEREAS, New Jersey Natural Gas Company has heretofore been granted a franchise and consent to lay, maintain and operate gas facilities in the Borough of Red Bank; and

WHEREAS, New Jersey Natural Gas Company is desirous of obtaining a franchise and consent of the municipality to continue serving the municipality.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Borough of Red Bank hereby consents and authorizes New Jersey Natural Gas Company to lay, maintain and operate for a period of fifty (50) years from the date hereof, its conductors, mains and pipes together with all appurtenances thereto, in, under and over all the public streets, alleys, squares and public places in the Borough of Red Bank for the purpose of conducting, transmitting and distributing gas or any mixture of gases of various types, including natural gas, upon the following terms and conditions and rules, regulations and ordinances of the Borough of Red Bank:

1. That New Jersey Natural Gas Company shall agree that, in all cases in which street openings or excavations are made for the purposes aforesaid, the pavement and surface of the streets, alleys, squares or roadways shall be restored to the same condition as existed prior to the opening thereof, and in accordance with Borough Ordinances; and
2. That New Jersey Natural Gas Company shall conduct the work or the laying or maintaining of gas pipes therein in a careful and prudent manner; and
3. That New Jersey Natural Gas Company shall safeguard the public interest in continuous and uninterrupted service at and after the expiration of the term of the grant; and
4. That New Jersey Natural Gas Company shall maintain its property in good order throughout the full term of the grant; and
5. That New Jersey Natural Gas Company shall continuously afford safe, adequate and proper service at just and reasonable rates.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this franchise consent, upon approval of the Board of Public Utilities of the State of New Jersey, shall supersede the Resolution granted by the Borough of Red Bank on March 17, 1969; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that New Jersey Natural Gas Company shall file with the clerk of this municipality within sixty (60) days from the date hereof, its acceptance of the terms and provisions of the franchise consent herein granted and its agreement to be bound by the terms and provisions thereof; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this resolution shall not become effective unless and until it is approved by the Board of Public Utilities of the State of New Jersey.
