DECISION AND ORDER

BY THE BOARD:

In 2001, the Board of Public Utilities ("Board") first approved the use of an Internet-based descending clock auction ("Auction") for the procurement of Basic Generation Service ("BGS"). That Auction took place in February 2002. The decision to procure BGS through this type of Auction process was made following a review of alternative options that were considered and debated in written comments and at public hearings open to all interested parties. Since that time the Board has authorized the State's four electric distribution companies ("EDCs") to conduct four additional descending clock auctions to procure BGS service. Each decision was made following a process similar to that conducted in 2001 and each provided ample opportunity for all interested parties, including the general public, to comment and propose alternatives to the descending clock auction.

In 2001 and, to a lesser extent, in the 2002 review process some alternatives to a descending clock auction were put forth during the comment period. The Board considered these comments and determined that an Auction was the best procurement vehicle under prevailing market conditions. Beginning with the 2003 process, comments from the industry focused much more on modifications to the previous auctions with considerably less interest expressed in foregoing a descending clock auction for some other form of procurement vehicle. In the past three BGS procurement proceedings, a significant portion of the filed comments have focused on the retail margin, the size of the hourly-priced customer class and the supplier contract. The Board has been willing to consider and address these subjects in each of its BGS Orders and, to the extent that parties continue to see these matters as the areas of import, it will continue to do so.

While the Board and staff annually consider whether a descending clock auction is the appropriate vehicle for BGS procurement, it is important that the Board also hear from industry participants and the public on this subject. The Board Order approving the 2006 BGS procurement process expressed tentative support for conducting a descending clock auction in 2007. It also indicated that there would be opportunity for public comment. (Order dated December 8, 2005, Docket No. EO05040317). Therefore, the Board is initiating the 2007 BGS procurement process at this time with a consideration of just the procurement process, policy issues directly related thereto and issues that are of particular interest to the Board and warrant

individual consideration. Attached hereto, as Attachment A, is a schedule and a set of questions intended to facilitate such a review.

For the foregoing reasons, the Board ADOPTS the preliminary procedural schedule in Attachment A to this Order and DIRECTS any interested party to file preliminary responses to the questions in Attachment A by April 6, 2006. Interested parties should file comments with the Board's Secretary and circulate them electronically through the electric list server used by the industry for these types of communications. Parties should adhere to the attached schedule unless otherwise directed by Staff. Parties will be advised of the time and place of the legislative-style hearing identified in Attachment A through the electric list server used by Staff for these types of communications. The Board and/or Staff will also notify parties through the electric list server and, when possible, through the BPU webpage of the time and location of any meetings or hearings as well as any schedule changes.

Following consideration of the issues identified herein, the Board will issue an Order setting forth the manner and timeframe in which other matters related to BGS procurement for 2007 will be considered.
